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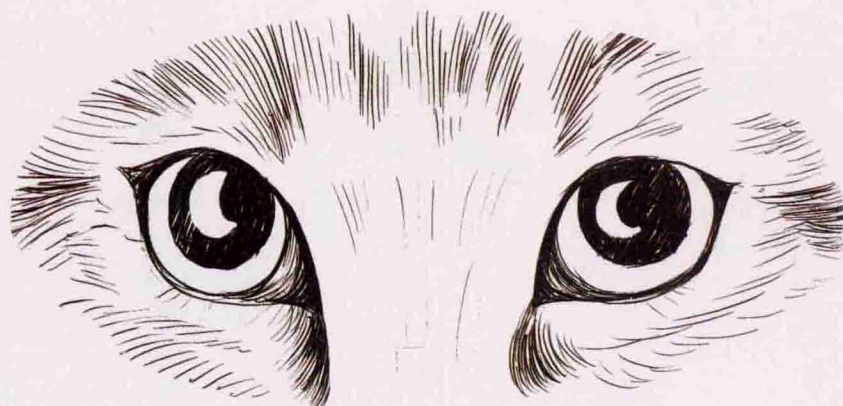
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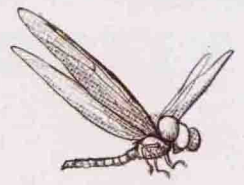
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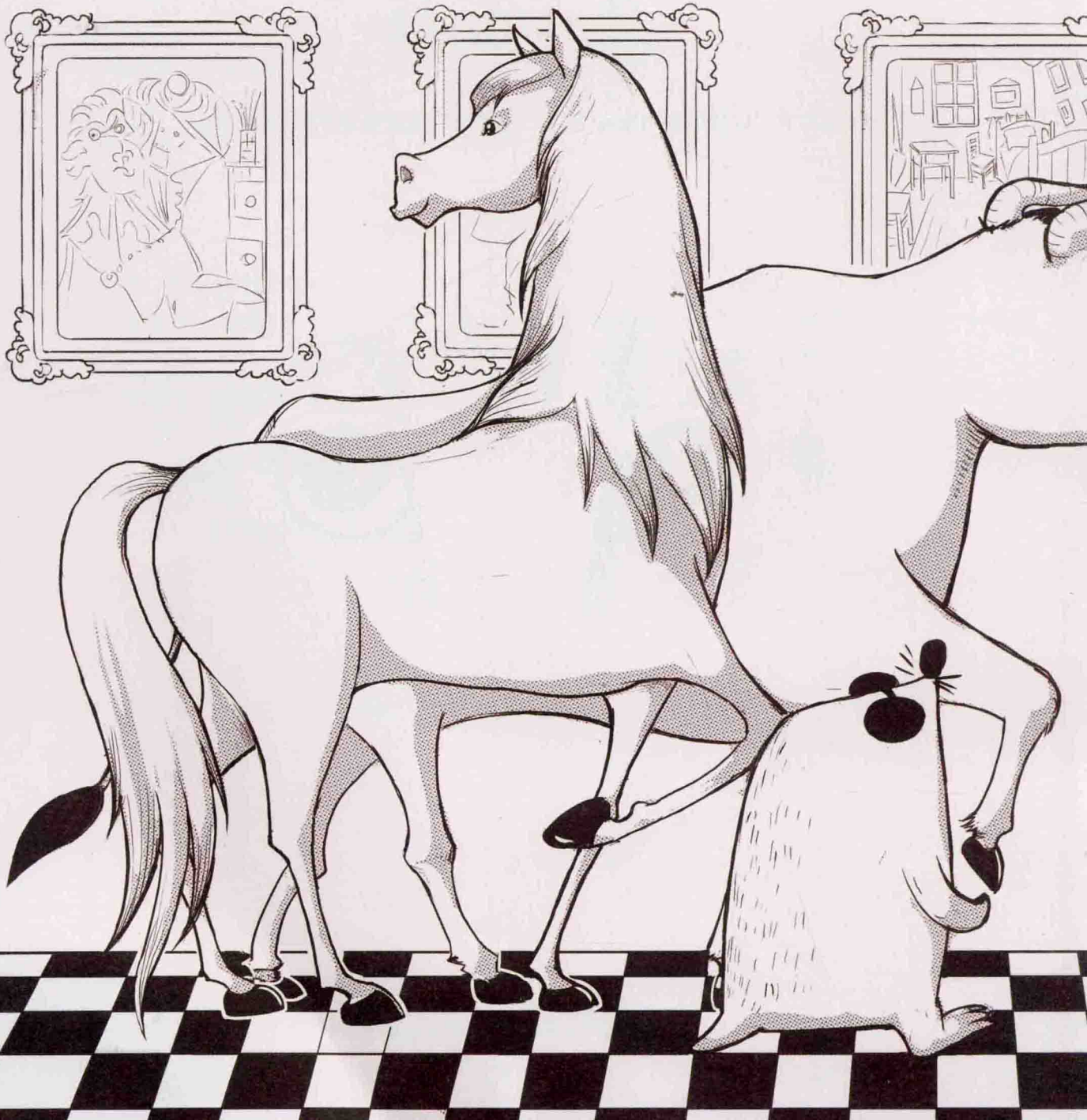
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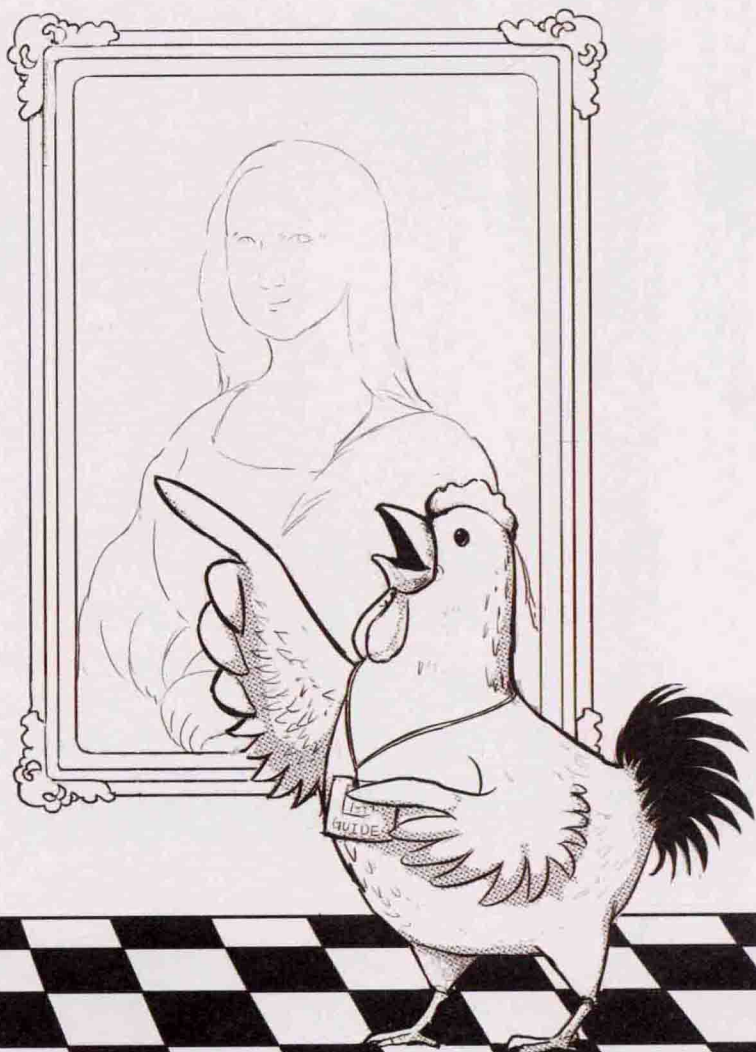
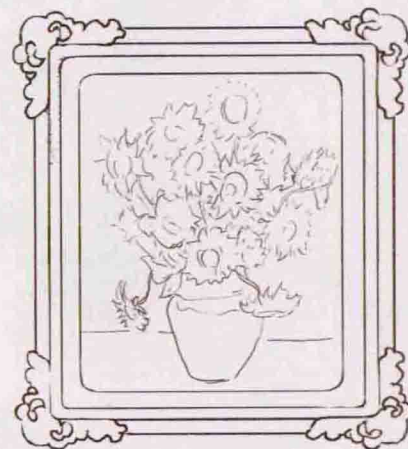
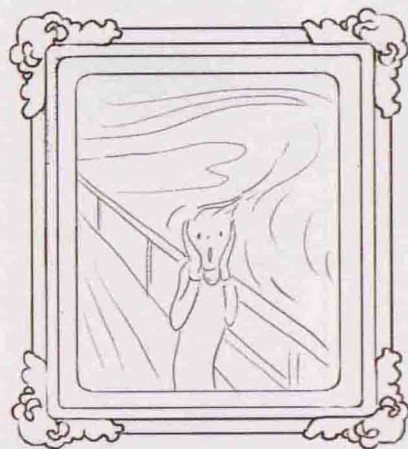


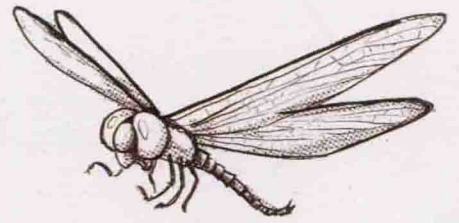
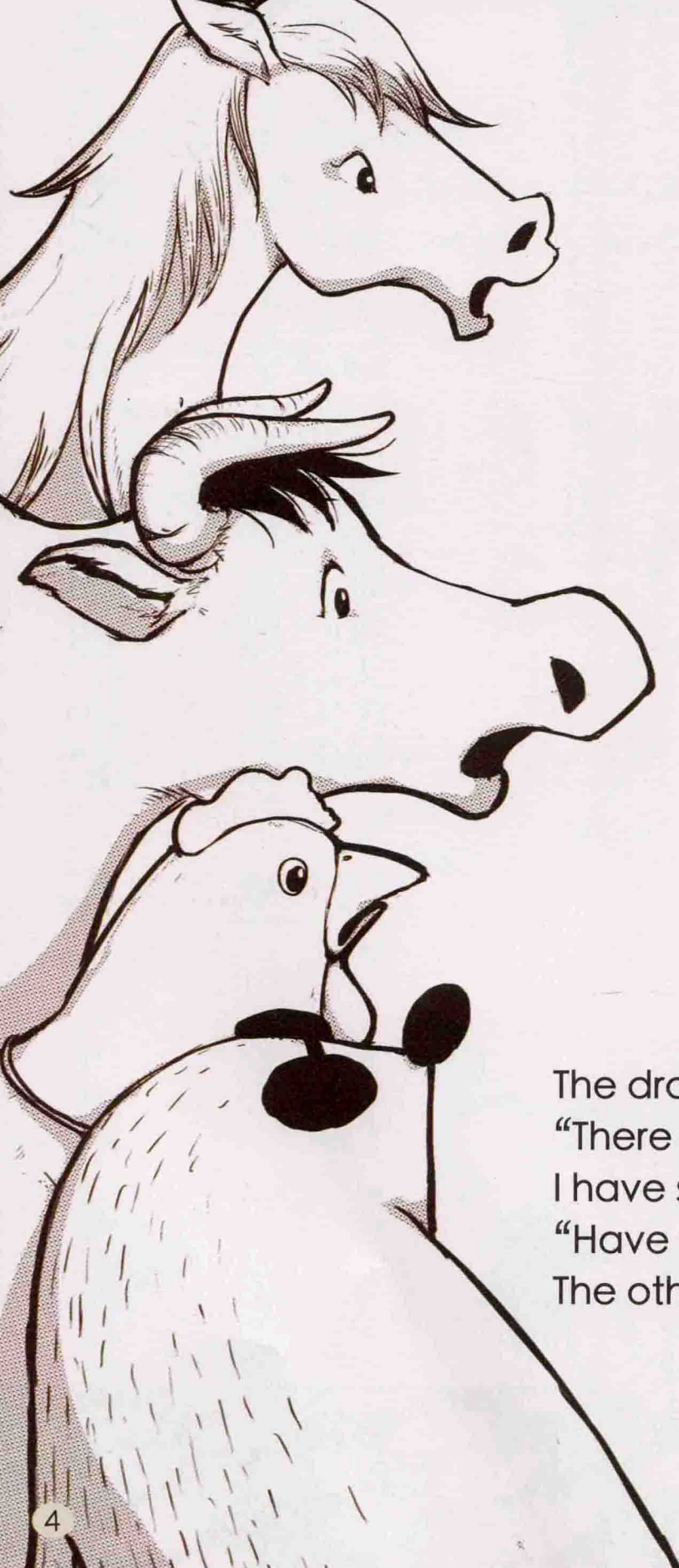
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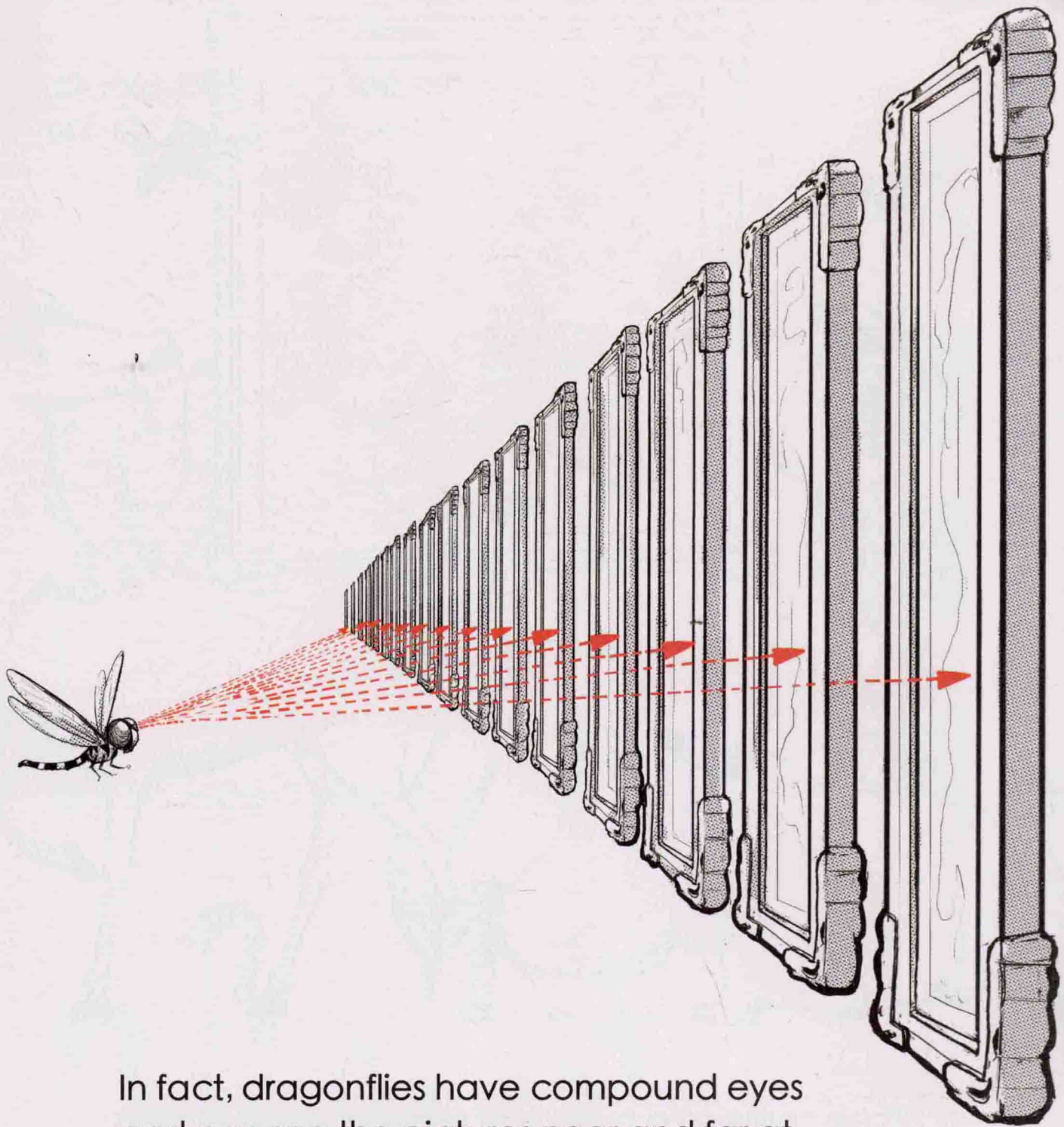
During the weekend,

The guide, a hen, began to introduce the pictures.



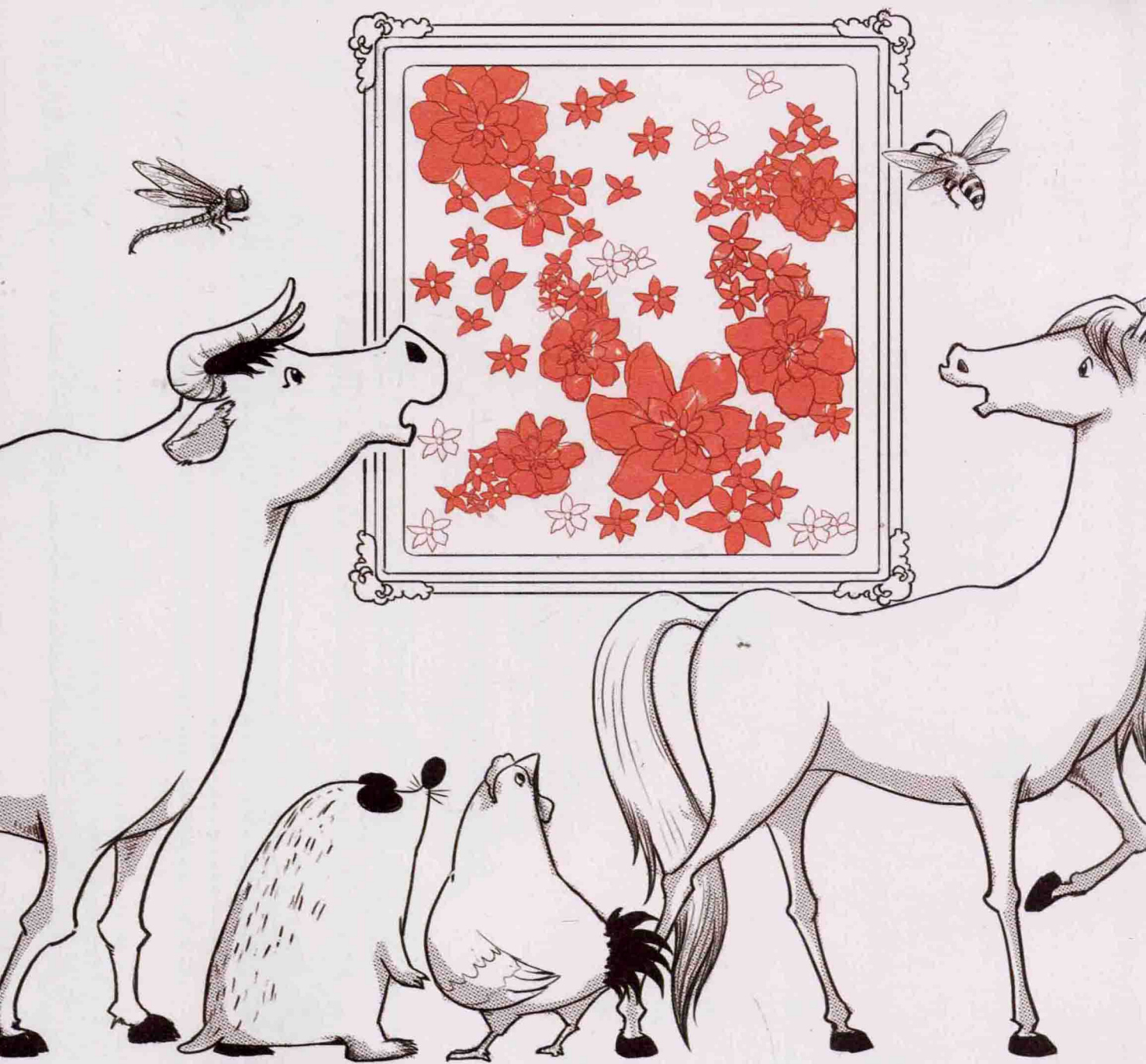




The dragonfly said,

The other animals were curious.

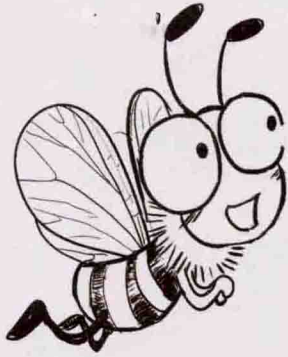


In fact, dragonflies have compound eyes and can see the pictures near and far at the same time.

yellow, blue, and green.

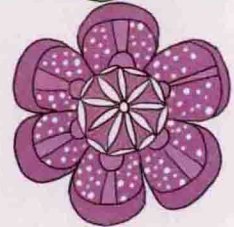
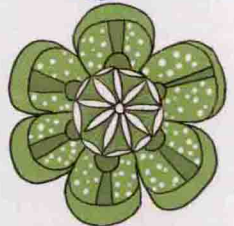
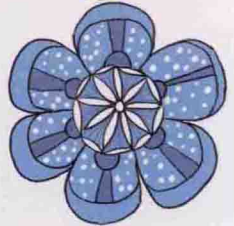
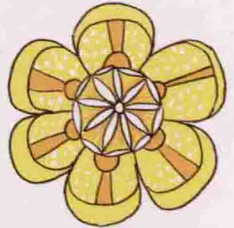

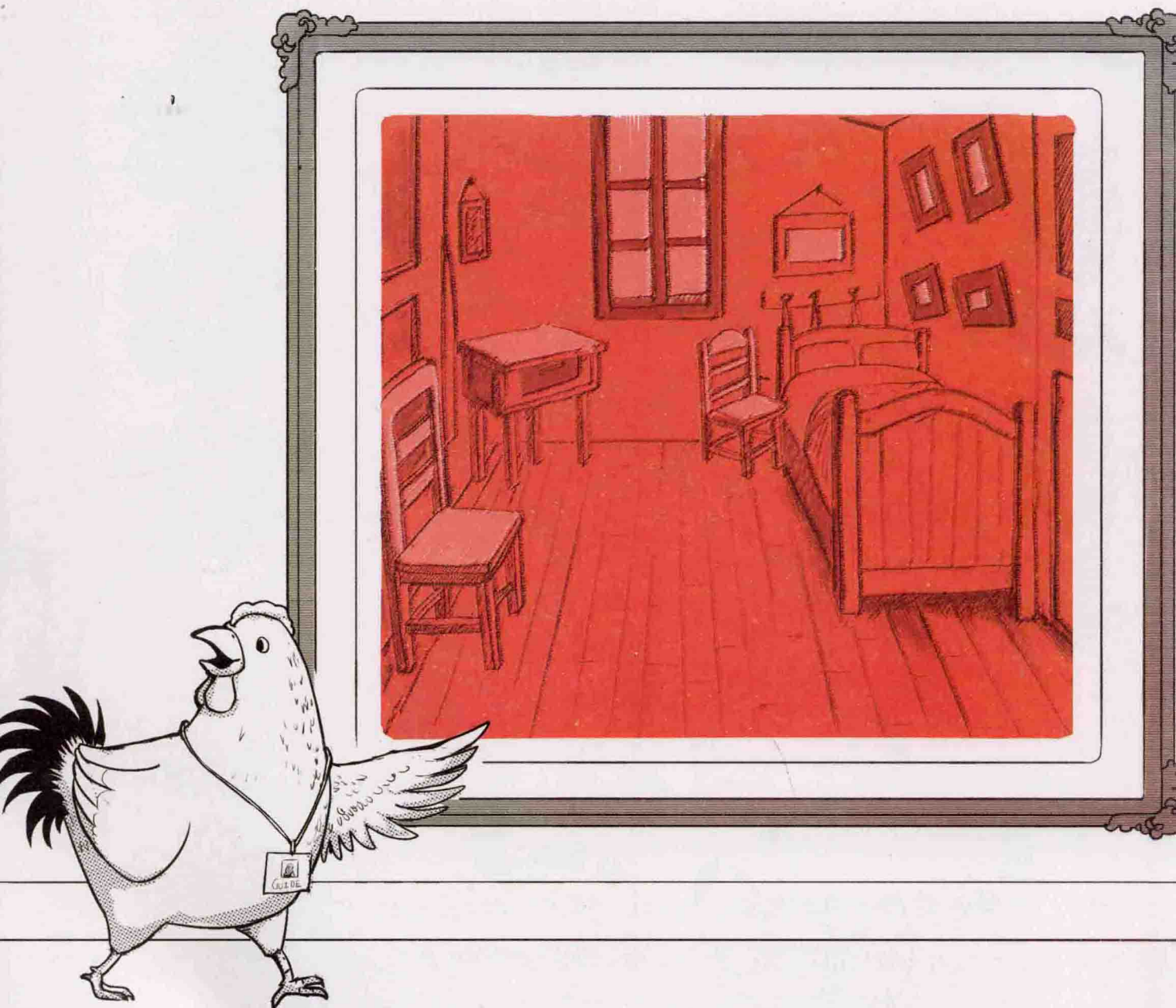
But bees can't see red.



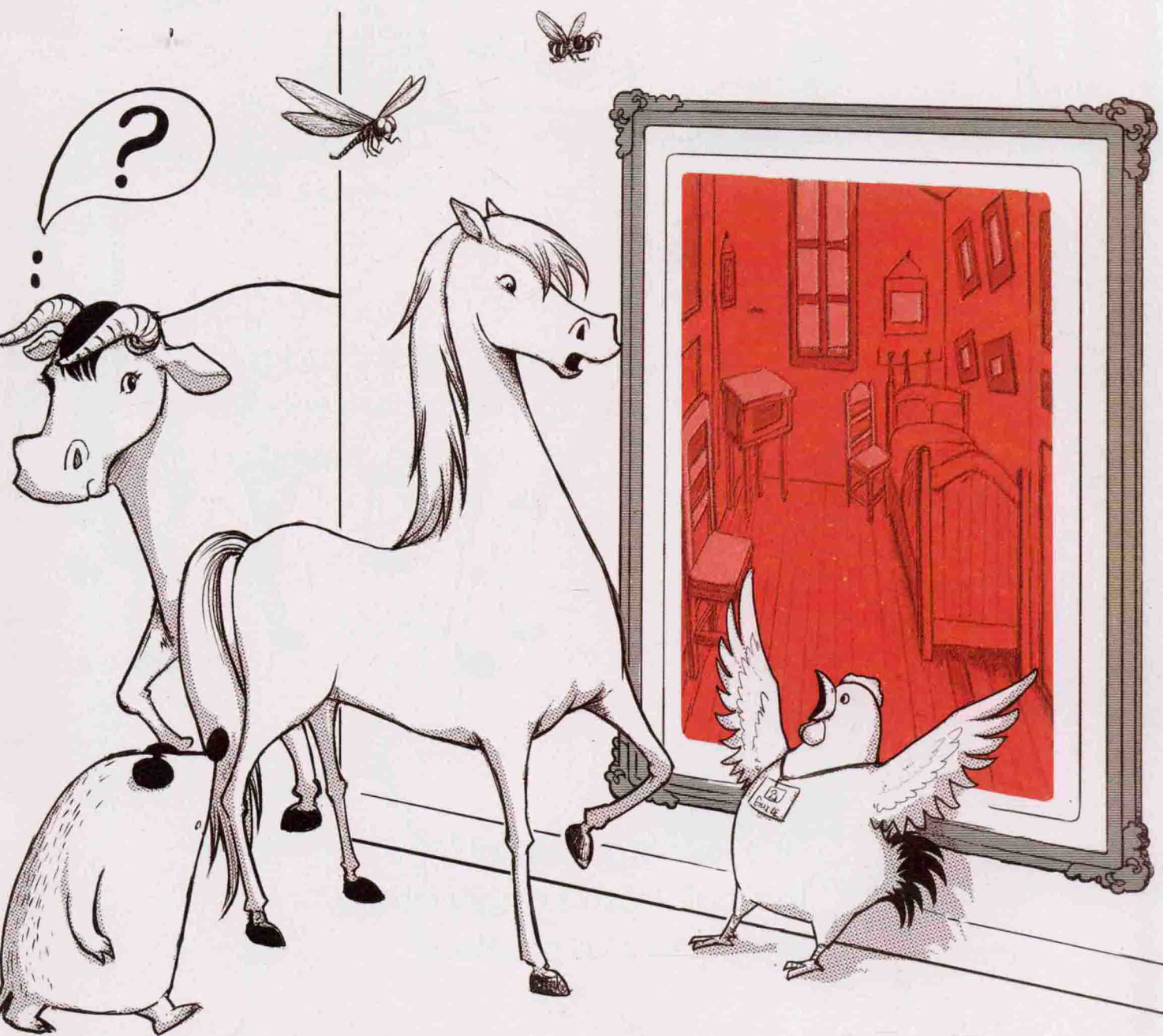
"This way please."

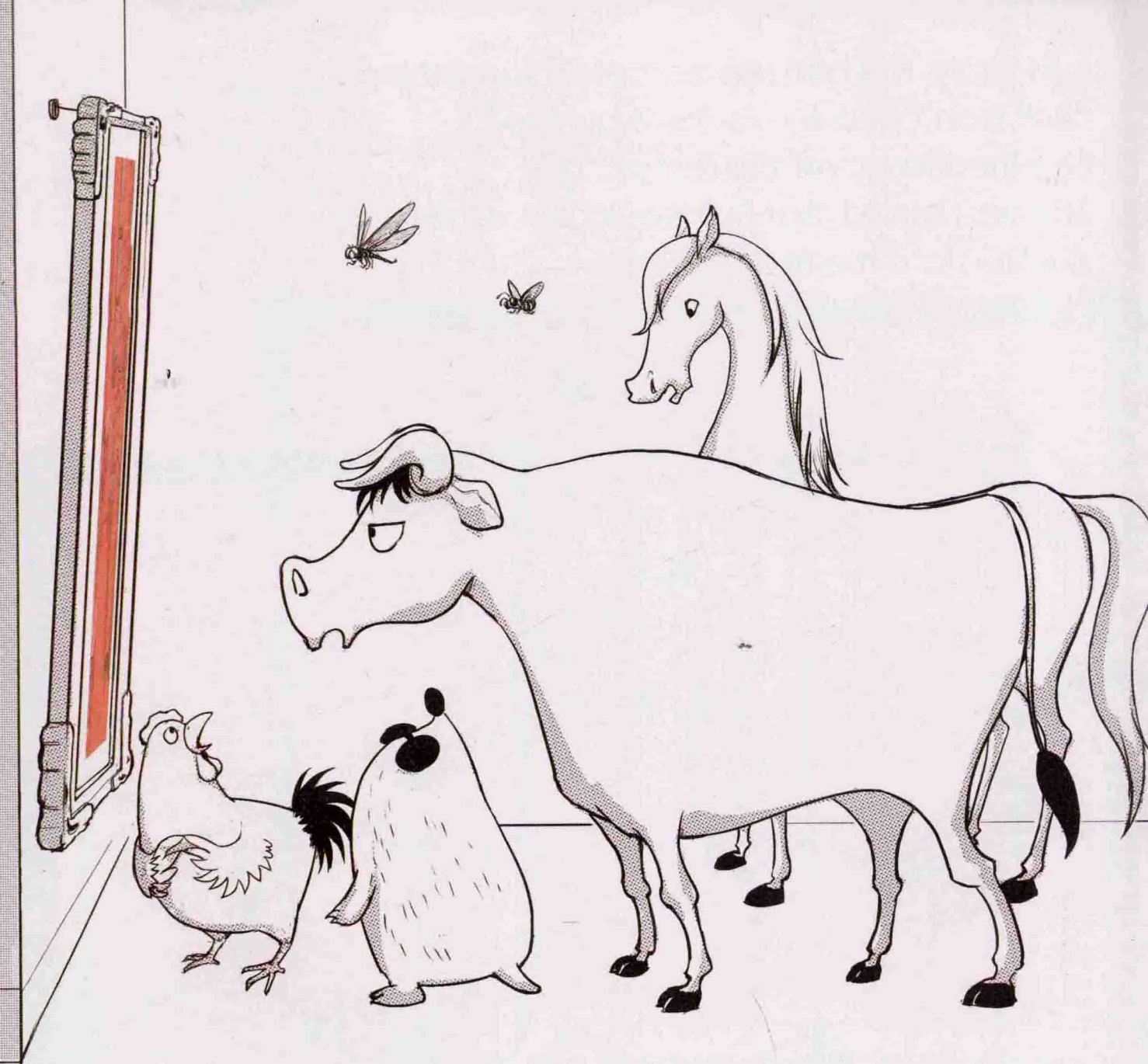
They came to a picture of a red room.

Everything in the room was red.

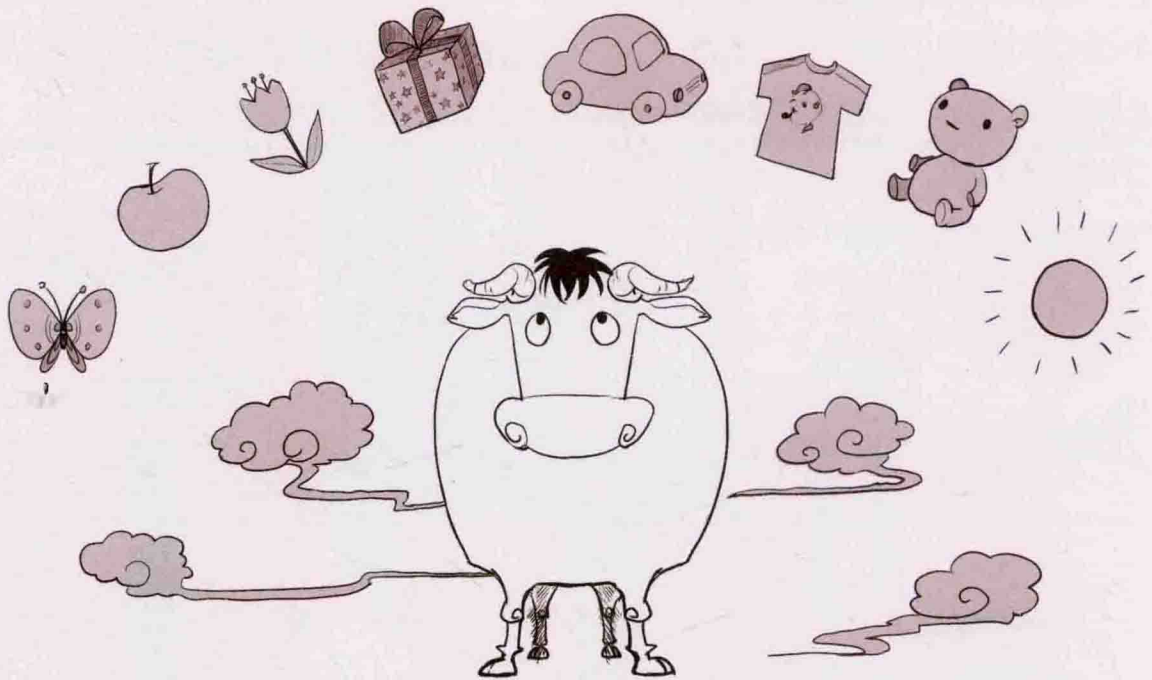


Suddenly, the hen remembered something,

and run into the red picture.

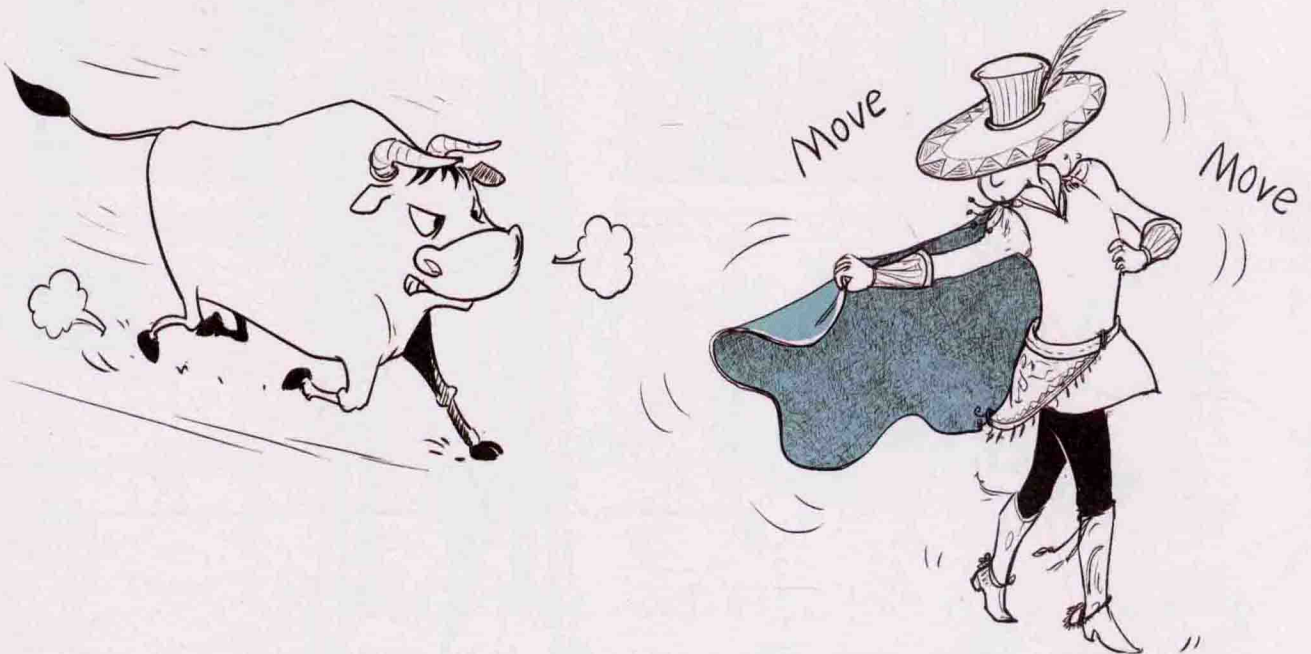




“It’s nothing special.”

but moving things.



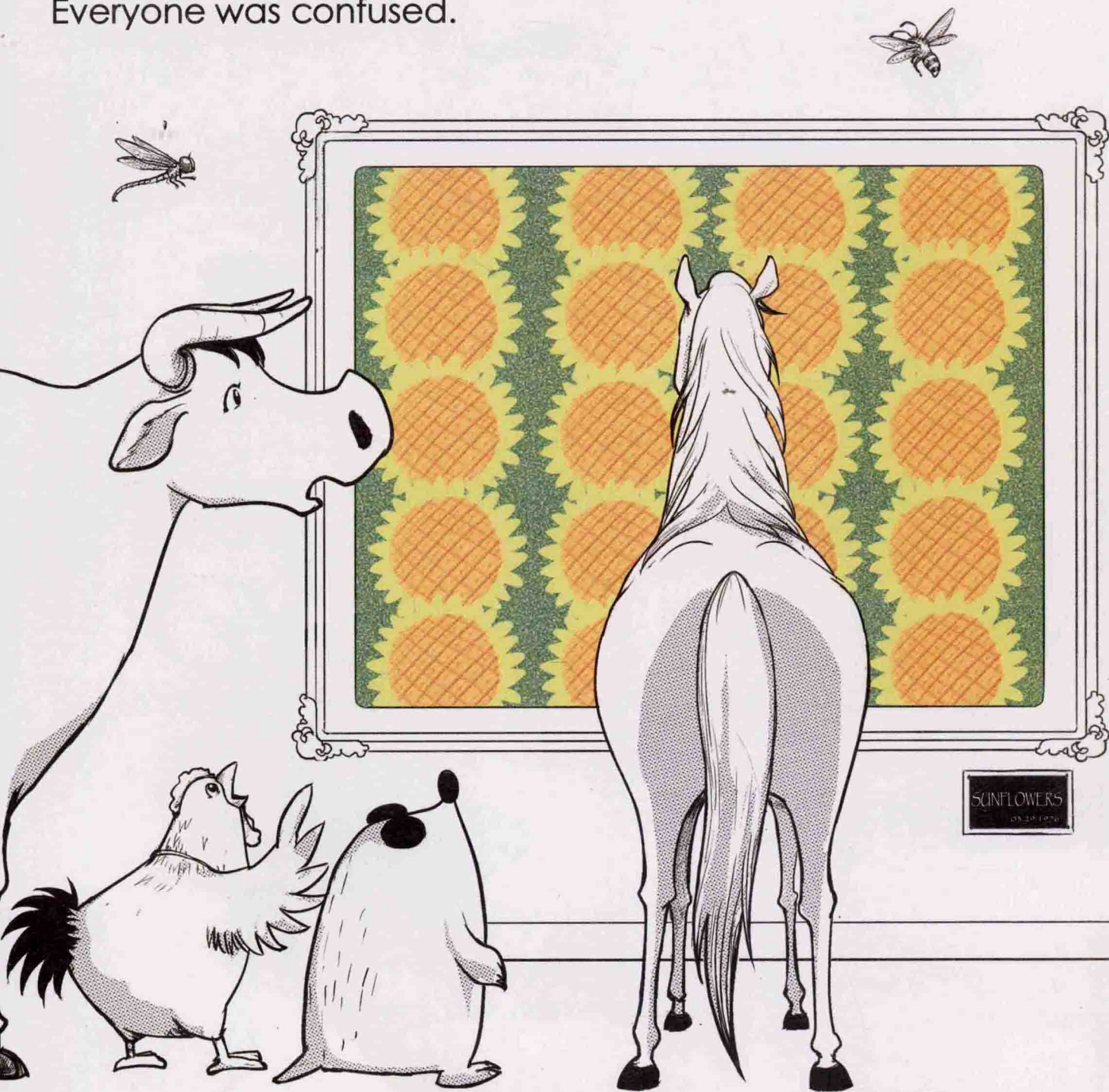
They went on to look around.

Everyone was confused.



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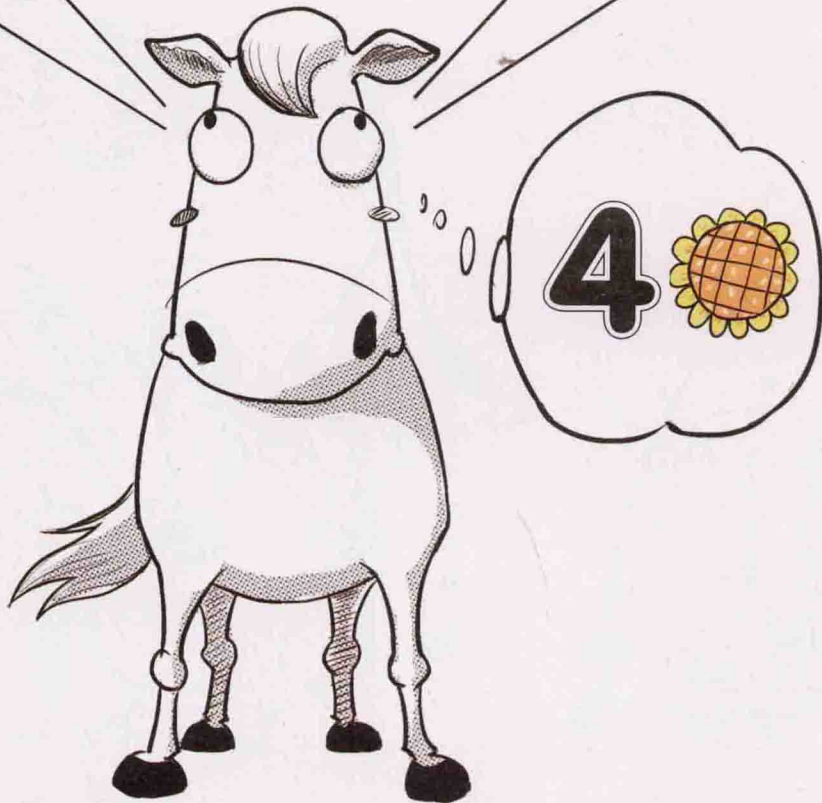
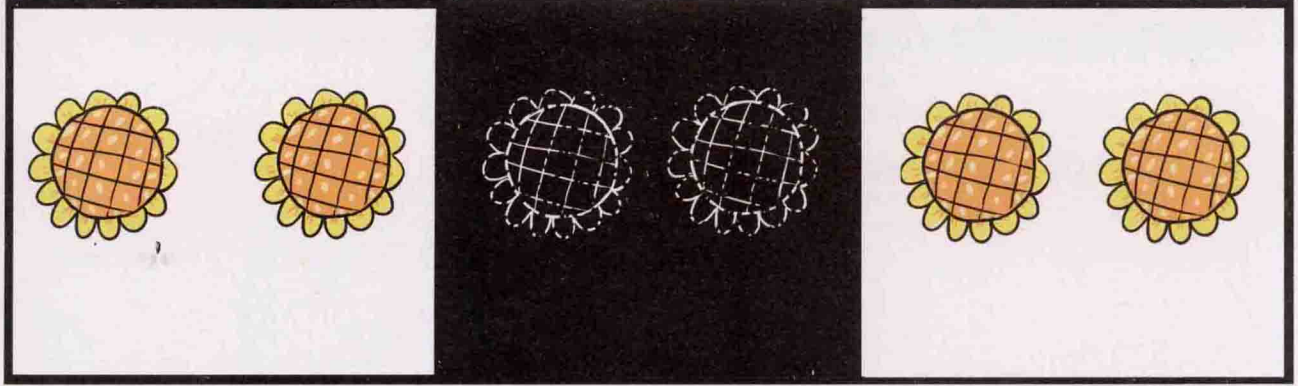
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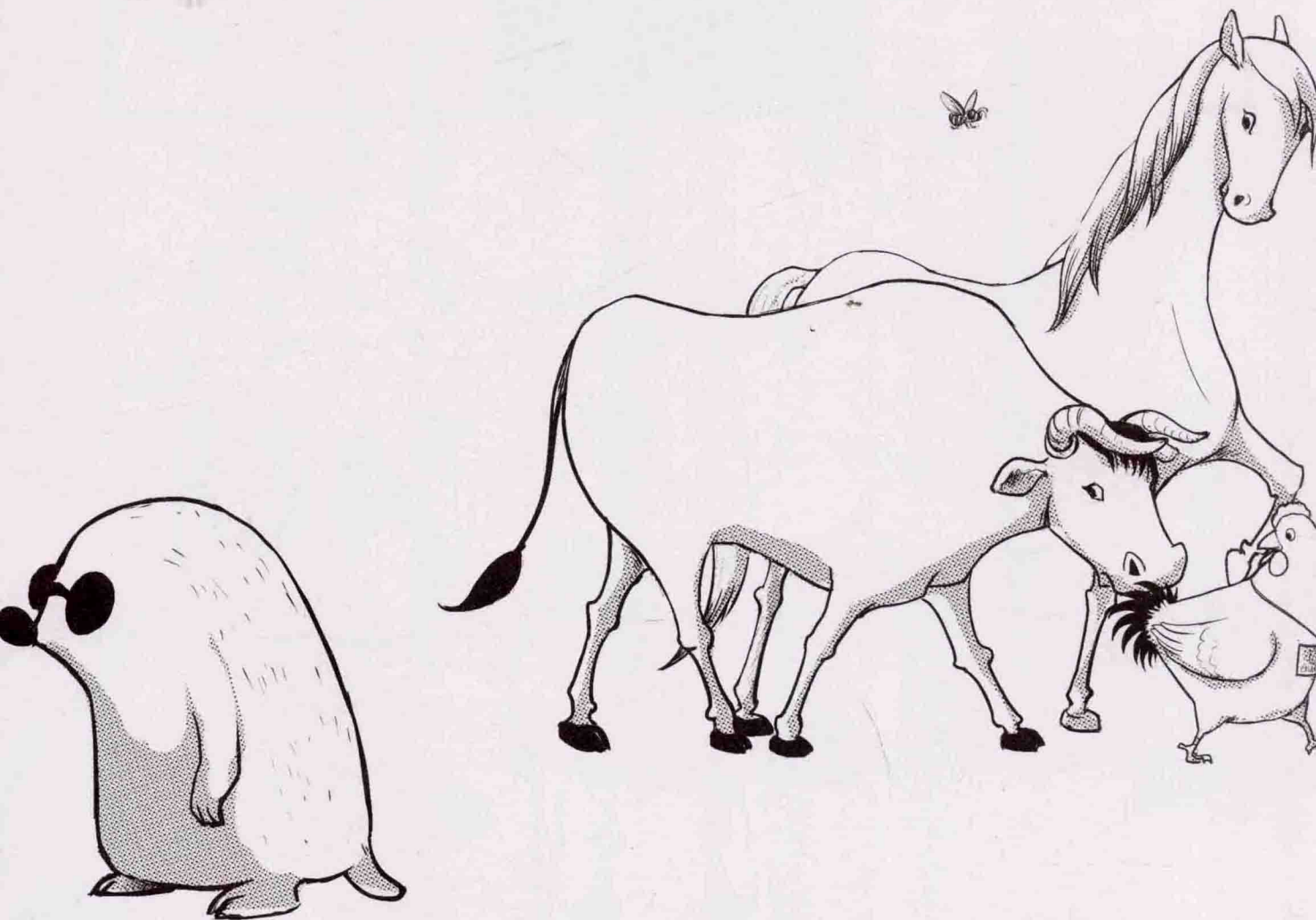
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Actually, horses can't see things directly in front of their two eyes.
