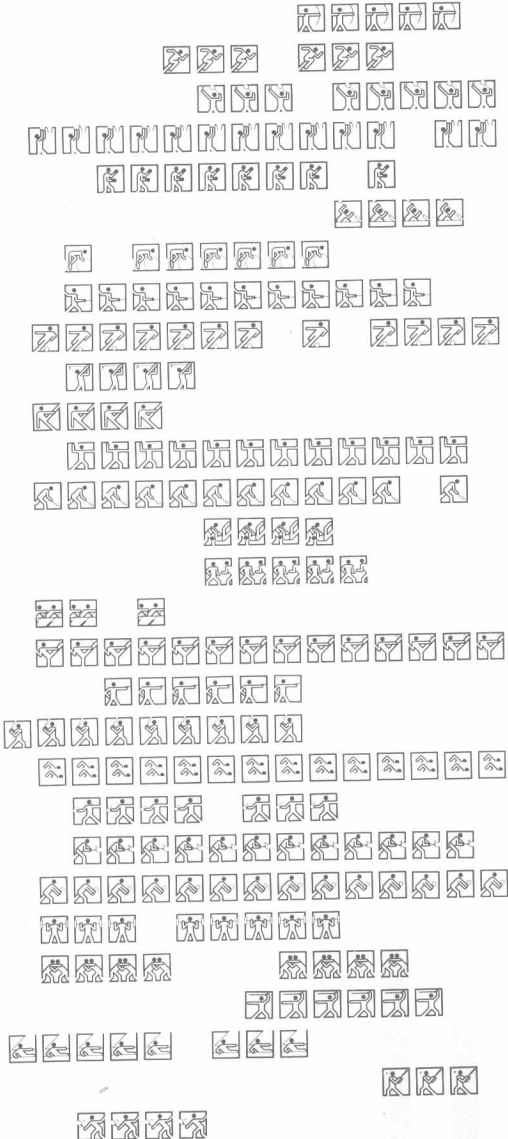

1. Dates and Place

The 11th Asian Games table tennis competition will be held in Beijing from September 24 through October 1, 1990.

2. Venues

2.1. Competition Site

The Beijing Workers' Gymnasium, which is located in the eastern part of Beijing, 6-7 km from the Asian Games Village, with a seating capacity of 12,000.

2.2. Training Sites

The Training Halls of the Beijing Workers' Gymnasium and the Beijing Workers' Sports Complex.

This schedule is subject to change depending on the number of participating teams.

5. Participants

5.1. Only athletes who comply with the Constitution and Rules of the Olympic Council of Asia (OCA) and the Rules of the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF) are entitled to take part in the 11th Asian Games table tennis competition.

5.2. Each OCA member may enter a maximum of five (5) men players and four (4) women players. Each OCA member may enter only one team in the men's and women's team events. In the individual events, each OCA member may enter a maximum of five (5) men players and four (4) women players in the singles events, two (2) pairs in the men's and women's doubles events, and four (4) pairs in the mixed doubles.

6. Entries

6.1. Preliminary Entry (by event and number)

The preliminary entry forms from all teams, forwarded through the respective OCA members, must be received by the 11th Asian Games Organizing Committee (BAGOC) not later than 24:00 hours (Beijing Time), June 22, 1990. (The BAGOC's address and telephone and telex numbers can be found on the entry forms.)

6.2. Final Entry (by event and name)

The final entry forms from all teams, forwarded through the respective OCA members, must be received by the BAGOC not later than 24:00 hours (Beijing Time), August 22, 1990. No changes or additional entries will be accepted af-

ter this time.

7. Competition Methods

7.1. The competition will be conducted in accordance with the current Rules of the ITTF. In case of disagreement in the interpretation of the Rules, the English text shall prevail. Any unforeseen incidents not covered by the Rules will be dealt with in accordance with the Constitution and Rules of the OCA, the ITTF and the Asian Table Tennis Union (ATTU).

7.2. Team Competition

7.2.1. Basis

Men — Swaythling Cup Best of nine matches in each tie.

Women — Corbillon Cup Best of five matches in each tie.

7.2.2. Competition in Two Stages

7.2.2.1. If 12–20 teams participate, they will be divided into four (4) groups playing the round robin system in Stage I. All the teams will be drawn into groups of four (4) teams each in accordance with the latest ITTF Classification List and each group will be headed by one of the first four (4) seeded teams in fixed order.

In Stage II, according to the results of Stage I, the No. 1 & No. 2 teams of each group — A, B, C & D — will play off on the progressive knockout method.

7.3. Individual Competition

The individual events will be played on a knockout basis. Matches will be determined by the best of five games in the singles events and by the best of three games in the doubles events.

7.4. Draw

The draw will take place in Beijing at 09:00 hours (Beijing Time) on August 24, 1990. All OCA members are welcome to send representatives to attend the draw.

8. Equipment

8.1. Balls: ITTF-approved "Double Happiness" balls made in China.

8.2. Tables, surroundings, supporting posts and nets are in conformity with the ITTF Rules.

8.3. The covering material on the racket used by the players must be of a brand and type currently authorized by the ITTF

9. Medical Control

9.1. Doping Control

Doping control tests will be conducted during the Asian Games table tennis competition in accordance with the regulations of the BAGOC and the ATTU. The number of competitors to undergo doping tests will be agreed upon by the BAGOC and the ATTU.

9.2. Femininity Control

Femininity control tests will be conducted for the 11th Asian Games in accordance with the regulations of the ITTF, except for those competitors who have obtained valid certificates of femininity issued by the ITTF.

10. Competition Management

10.1. The Table Tennis Commission of the BAGOC, with the participation of officials from the Chinese Table Tennis Association, will be responsible for the organization of the table tennis competition under the guidance of the ITTF and the ATTU.

10.2. Technical Officials

10.2.1. Referees and Umpires

The referee and deputy referees will be appointed by the Table Tennis Commission of the BAGOC, with one of the deputy referees coming from another OCA member than China.

At least 80 per cent of the umpires will be international umpires, 10 being invited from other OCA members than China.

10.2.2. Jury

A Jury will be set up by the BAGOC in consultation with the ATTU. The officials and members of the Jury must meet the requirements of the ITTF. The Jury will hold a meeting on the day before the start of competition and may meet

subsequently when it deems necessary.

10.2.3. Technical Delegate

A Technical Delegate from the OCA will be appointed by the ATTU.

10.3. Protests

10.3.1. An appeal may be made to the referee against the umpire's decision regarding the interpretation of Laws and Regulations, and the referee's decision shall be final.

10.3.2. An appeal may be made to the Chairman of the Technical Committee against the referee's decision on matters of tournament or match conduct not covered by the Laws or Regulations, and the Chairman's decision shall be final.

10.3.3. Protests must be made to the Jury within two hours after the decision was made, with the exception of special cases. The Jury must reach a decision after investigation and its decision shall be final. But the disqualification of a team or a player on account of violation of the Constitution and Rules of the OCA shall be decided by the Jury of Appeal.

10.3.4. Appeals and protests must be made in written form.

11. Prizes

11.1. Prizes will be awarded to the first six teams.
