Little Snow-White (白雪公主)

Snow-White was a princess, whose skin was as white as snow. But her mother died after her birth. Then the king found a **stepmother (继母)** for her. This new queen couldn't stand anyone who was more beautiful than her. She had a **magic mirror (魔镜)** and she always asked the mirror, "Who is the most beautiful lady in the world?" And the mirror would answer, "You are the most beautiful lady." The queen was **satisfied (满意的)**.

But one day, when the queen asked the same question, the magic mirror answered, "Snow-White." The queen was **mad (生气的)**. She asked a **servant (仆人)** to kill Snow-White in a forest. The servant didn't kill Snow-White because she **implored (乞求)** him. Snow-White was lost in the forest. She found a house, where she found some food and ate a lot, then she slept on a bed. **Some time later (不久)**, the owners came back. They were seven **dwarves (小矮人)**. They didn't **disturb (打扰)** her. The next day, Snow-White told them her story, and the seven dwarves permitted Snow-White to live in their house.



The queen thought Snow-White was dead, so she asked the magic mirror, “Who is the most beautiful lady in the world?” Then the mirror answered, “You aren’t the most beautiful lady. Snow-White is alive.” The queen was angry. She firstly dressed herself as an old woman who sold groceries (杂货). Then she dressed herself as another woman who sold combs. But she failed to kill Snow-White. Snow-White was saved by the dwarves. The queen was crazy, then she made a poisonous (有毒的) apple. She dressed herself as an old woman and gave the apple to Snow-White from the window. After eating the apple, Snow-White fainted (晕倒). This time, the queen asked the mirror the same question and the magic mirror said, “You are the most beautiful lady in the world now!” When the dwarves came back home, they found they couldn’t wake up Snow-White. They felt sad and then they prepared a crystal coffin (水晶棺) for her. They laid her in it.



One day, a prince saw Snow-White and fell in love with her, then he begged the dwarves to let him take her away. The dwarves agreed finally. The prince had the coffin carried



away by his servants on their shoulders. Snow-White accidentally (意外地) hit the coffin, and spat (吐) out the apple. The prince proposed (求婚) to her, and she agreed. One day the queen asked the same question. The mirror replied (回复), “The wife of a prince is the most beautiful lady.” The queen went to see the prince’s wife, and she found it was Snow-White, then the queen fell ill and died. Snow-White and the prince lived a happy life.



阅读链接

白雪公主 (Snow-White) 是广泛流传于欧洲 (Europe) 的一个童话故事中的角色 (character), 其中最著名的一个版本 (edition) 是德国雅各·格林和威廉·格林 (后人习惯称呼他们为格林兄弟) 编写的。故事讲述了白雪公主受到继母 (stepmother) 的迫害, 在森林里遇到七个小矮人的故事。

1.prepare... for...

意为“为……准备……”。例句: I prepared a birthday gift for Mary. / 我为玛丽准备了一份生日

2.beg

意为“乞求，恳求”。beg sb. to do sth. 乞求某人做某事。如果只是单单乞求别人，可以直接用beg。例句：I beg you. / 我求你。I beg you to take a book for me. / 我求你帮我带本书。

Thumbelina（拇指姑娘）

Once upon a time, a woman wanted a cute girl, so she went to consult a witch. The witch said, “It’s so easy!” Then the witch gave her a grain of wheat（麦子） and asked her to put it into a flowerpot（花盆）. When the flower bloomed（绽放）, there sat upon the green stamens（花的雄蕊） a little girl. She was scarcely



as long as half a thumb, and therefore she was called Thumbelina. She had a good time with her mother. But one day, an ugly toad (癞蛤蟆) took her away to let her marry his son. Fishes felt pity (同情的), so they gnawed away the stem (柄) of a lotus (莲花) leaf on which Thumbelina stood. Then the lotus leaf floated down the stream, carrying Thumbelina to a foreign country. Then she was caught by beetles (甲虫) and the beetles took her to their house. But the beetles' friends thought Thumbelina was ugly, so they didn't want to play with her. Then the beetles abandoned her in a forest. Thumbelina drank dew (露水) and ate flowers. Then summer and autumn went by, and winter came. Thumbelina met a vole (田鼠, 仓鼠) and he invited Thumbelina to live with him. Thumbelina agreed.

One day, she saved an injured swallow (燕子) and took care of her. When the swallow's condition (状况) got better, she asked Thumbelina if she wanted to go with her. Thumbelina knew if she left, the vole would be sad, so she refused. Then the swallow flew away. A few days later, the vole said, "The richest man in our town—Mr. Mole (鼹鼠) will visit our house. If you marry him, you will have lots of money."





The next day, Mr. Mole was coming. Because his sight was poor, Mr. Mole couldn't see Thumbelina's face clearly. The vole asked Thumbelina to sing a song for Mr. Mole. Because of this song, Mr. Mole fell in love with her. However, Mr. Mole didn't express his love instantly. He waited for some days, then he proposed to her. To thank the vole, she agreed.

Then autumn was coming. Mr. Mole let Thumbelina make a wedding dress. But actually Thumbelina didn't like him at all. She liked sunshine and flowers, so she didn't want to live with him. One day, the swallow which was saved by Thumbelina was going to other countries. She asked Thumbelina, "Would you like to go to other countries with me?" Thumbelina agreed happily. So, the swallow took Thumbelina to another country and put her on the most beautiful flower. And there she met a boy as small as her. The boy was the king of flowers. She had a good time with him, then they fell in love with (爱上) each other. A few months later, they decided to get married. Then Thumbelina became the queen of flowers, and they lived happily.



阅读链接

《拇指姑娘》是世界著名童话作家安徒生（Hans Christian Andersen）的作品，这个童话发表在《讲给孩子们听的故事集》里。拇指姑娘救了一只燕子，那只燕子提议带拇指姑娘走，而拇指姑娘若是安于现状，接受命运（destiny）的安排，她也不会遇见花王子。这个童话告诉我们要像拇指姑娘一样善良，并且要勇于追求（pursue）自己想要的生活。



活学活用

1.abandon

做动词时为“抛弃，终止，丢弃”的意思，后面可以直接接名词；做名词时则为“放任，放纵”的意思。例句：He abandoned his child. / 他抛弃了他的孩子。The road is strewn with abandoned cars. / 这条街上散布着被遗弃的车。

2.as... as...

意为“和……一样……”。例句：The girl is as beautiful as her mother. / 这个小女孩跟她妈妈一样漂亮。



into the world, and try to learn a trade (学一门手艺), and when you all come back, he who makes the best masterpiece (杰作) shall have the house.”

The sons were well content with (对……感到满意) this, and the eldest determined to be (决定做……) a blacksmith (铁匠), the second a barber (剃头匠), and the third a fencing-master (剑客). They fixed a time when they should all come home, and then each went his way.

It so happened that they all found skilful masters (大师), who taught them their trades well. When the appointed (约定的) time came, the three brothers came back home. But they did not know how to find the best opportunity (机会) to show their skill, so they sat down and consulted (商量) together. As they were sitting, all at once (突然) a hare came running across the field. “Ah, ha, just in time!” said the barber. So he took his basin (盆) and soap and shaved off (剃掉) the hare’s whiskers (胡须) and did not even cut its skin or injure a hair on its body. “Well done!” said the old man. “Your brothers will have to express themselves wonderfully, or the house will be yours.”

Soon after (不久), a nobleman (贵族) in his coach went through at full speed. “Now you shall see what I can do, father,” said the blacksmith. He ran after the coach, took all four shoes off the feet of one of the



horses and put on four new shoes without stopping it. “You are as clever as your younger brother,” said his father. “I do not know to whom I ought to give the house.”

Then the third son said, “Father, now it’s my turn.” As it was beginning to rain, he drew his sword, and flourished (挥舞) his sword faster and faster, and remained as dry as if he were sitting in a house. When his father saw this he was amazed, and said, “This is the masterpiece. The house is yours!”

His brothers were satisfied with this. As they loved one another very much, they three all stayed together in the house and followed their trades. They lived together happily until they grew old. And because they had loved one another so much, they were all laid in the same grave (坟墓).

1. come into one's mind

意为“想起，涌上心头”。除此之外，come into 的常用短语还有 come into power（当选，就职）、come into action（开始起作用）等。例句：An idea has just come into my mind. / 我刚想到一个主意。

2. be satisfied with...

意为“对……感到满意”。除此之外，be content with... 和 be pleased with... 也有“对……感到满意”的意思，可以替换使用。例句：People tend to be satisfied with what they have: a full belly, a warm home, good kids, good health. / 人们倾向满足于他们所拥有的：饱腹、温暖的家、听话的孩子和健康的身体。

A king recruited (招募) many soldiers for a war, but he didn't give them enough food. So three soldiers decided to run away (逃跑). In order not to be found, they hid themselves in a corn field (玉米地). They wanted to run away after the other soldiers left. But the army still stayed here after two days. They were so hungry. When they met a dragon (龙), the dragon asked them what had happened, and they told the dragon the whole thing.

“If you will be my servants for seven years,” the dragon said, “I can take you away.” The soldiers agreed. The dragon brought them to a safe place. Then they found the dragon was a devil. The dragon gave them a whip (鞭子) and said, “If you whip (抽打) with it and crack it, you can get lots of gold. But seven years later, you will be my servants.” He asked them to sign (签字) on a book, then he said, “I will give you a riddle (谜题). If you can give me the right answer, you will be free.” Then the dragon flew away.

When they started whipping, they got a lot of gold, and they lived rich lives. But when thinking of the arrangement (约定), they were nervous (紧张的).
