Smoking is a habit that's closely linked to certain times and places. If you break these links, you can break the habit. The best way of doing this is to avoid the situations where you want a cigarette. If you can't avoid them, then you will have to fight off the temptation. With friends in the pub? Once you stop smoking, these times and places are going to be the danger spots, so work out how you are going to deal with them.

Some people find it helps if they cut down on cigarettes before they actually give up. It's one way of preparing for the day you stop for good.
