They are juicy and crunchy. They are very good for you. Apples have skin, flesh, a core, seeds, a stem and leaves.

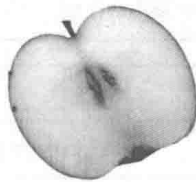


PARTS OF AN APPLE

- ★ The flesh is the juicy part inside.
- ★ The core is in the middle. It has seeds in it.
- ★ The seeds are small and brown. They can grow into new apple trees if you plant them and take care of them.
- ★ The stem is the little twig that holds the apple on the tree. It brings food and water into the apple.
- ★ The leaves cover the branches of the apple tree. The leaves make food for the apple so it can grow.
