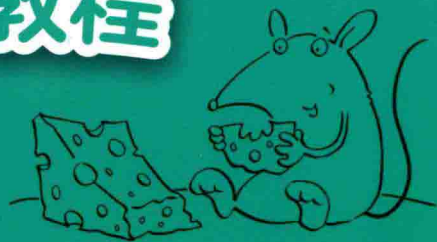

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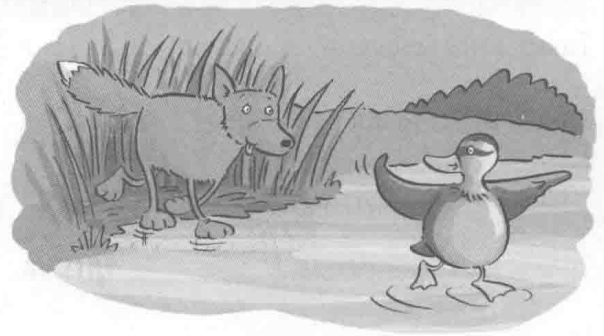
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Mrs Duck Meets Mr Fox 🐾

The Crocodile's Toothache 🎵

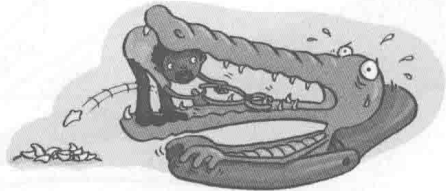
The Crocodile went to the dentist.





