## PREFACE

WITH this volume the collection of British International Law Cases touching the international law of peace is brought to completion. The collection, it may be of interest to note, contains 710 decisions and into its 4881 pages are compressed approaching ten thousand pages of the original reports.

In the Preface to Volume I of the series it was stated that it would be a matter for consideration whether it should not be extended to include the cases on the laws of war and neutrality as well as those on the law of peace. Investigation reveals, however, that this would involve enlarging the series to twice its size and the proposal has, therefore, been abandoned for the present. But it is now proposed to follow the present series up with a further two volumes to be entitled Commonwealth International Law Cases, containing a selection of the comparable decisions of courts of the Commonwealth oversea. It is also under consideration whether the British International Law Cases themselves ought not at some date to be supplemented by a further volume or volumes collecting the decisions subsequent to the year 1950, the date at which the present collection, for reasons stated in the original Preface, stops.

As that Preface explains, the collection has been produced under the joint auspices of the British Institute of International and Comparative Law and of the International Law Fund. The Editor desires to express his best thanks to these institutions for their continued interest in the venture, as well as to the Publishers and Printers. He wishes also to place on record his indebtedness to his former pupils and present colleagues, Mr. J. A. Hopkins and Mr. J. G. Collier, the former of whom has been very largely responsible for the successive editions of the Consolidated Index and the latter of whom has shared with the Editor and his wife much of the burden of proof-reading. He wishes also to acknowledge once more the manifold services of his secretary, Mrs. A. M. Jansen.
