jaw [dʒɔ:]

n. 下颌，腭

英文释义:

The jaw is any opposable articulated structure at the entrance of the mouth, typically used for grasping and manipulating food.

例句:

The surgeon realigned my jaw after the accident.

事故后，外科医师重新调整了我的下颌。

Her joints ache if she exercises.

n. 肾

英文释义:

The kidneys are organs that serve several essential regulatory roles in human body. They that take waste matter from blood and send it out of the body as urine.

例句:

The surgeon has done several kidney transplants.

这位外科医师已做了几次肾移植手术。

n. 膝盖

英文释义:

The knee joint joins the thigh with the lower leg and consists of two articulations: one between the femur and tibia, and one between the femur and patella.

例句:

He will receive physiotherapy on his damaged left knee.

因左膝受伤，他将接受物理治疗。

n. 膝盖骨

英文释义:

The kneecap is a thick, circular-triangular bone which articulates with the femur and covers and protects the anterior articular surface of the knee joint.

例句:

A common complaint among long-distance runners, runner's knee feels like a soreness around and sometimes behind the kneecap.

n. 指关节

英文释义:

The knuckles are the joints of the fingers which are brought into prominence when the hand is clenched and a fist is made.

例句:

Mr. Brenda's knuckles were white as she gripped the arms of the chair.

布伦达先生握紧椅子扶手时指关节都变白了。

laboratory [lə'bdɒrə,t(ə)rɪ]

n. 化验室

英文释义:

A laboratory is a facility that provides controlled conditions in which medical research, experiments, and measurement may be performed.

例句:

I'll write a slip and you can take it to the laboratory. Wait for a while and pick up the report, and then bring it back to me.

我给您开一张化验单。您带着化验单到化验室去。检查完后，请把化验报告给我送过来。

L large intestine [lɑ:dʒ in'testɪn]

大肠

英文释义:

The large intestine is the last part of the digestive system in human body. Its function is to absorb water from the remaining indigestible food matter, and then to pass useless waste material from the body.

例句:

Food can sit in the large intestine for up to two days.

食物可停留在大肠达 2 天。

潜伏期

英文释义:

Latency (incubation) period is the time elapsed between exposure to a pathogenic organism, a chemical or radiation, and when symptoms and signs are first apparent. In a typical infectious disease, latency period signifies the period taken by the multiplying organism to reach a threshold necessary to produce symptoms in host.

例句:

Patients usually become symptomatic after a latency period of hours to days.

病人通常在数小时或数天的潜伏期后才出现症状。

n. 腿

英文释义:

The human leg is the entire lower extremity or limb of the human body, including the foot, shank, thigh and even the hip or gluteal region.

例句:

My legs become painful following strenuous exercise.
激烈运动后，我的腿就痛。

n. 晶状体

英文释义:

The lens is a transparent, biconvex structure in the eye that, along with the cornea, helps to refract light to be focused on the retina. The lens, by changing shape, functions to change the focal distance of the eye so that it can focus on objects at various distances, thus allowing a sharp real image of the object of interest to be formed on the retina.

例句:

Cloudiness near the center of the lens usually interferes with clear sight.

n. 白血病

英文释义:

Leukemia is a type of cancer of the blood or bone marrow characterized by an abnormal increase of immature white blood cells called "blasts". Leukemia is a broad term covering a spectrum of diseases.

例句:

Leukemia is one of the common tumors, and it seriously harms to the health.

白血病是人类最常见的恶性肿瘤之一，严重威胁人的身心健康。

libido [li'bi:dəʊ]

n. 性欲

英文释义:

Libido or colloquially sex drive is a person's overall sexual drive or desire for sexual activity. Libido is determined by biological, psychological, and social factors.

例句:

In fact, feeling tired and stressed is probably the number one libido-killer.

实际上，感觉疲劳和压力可能是头号性欲杀手。
