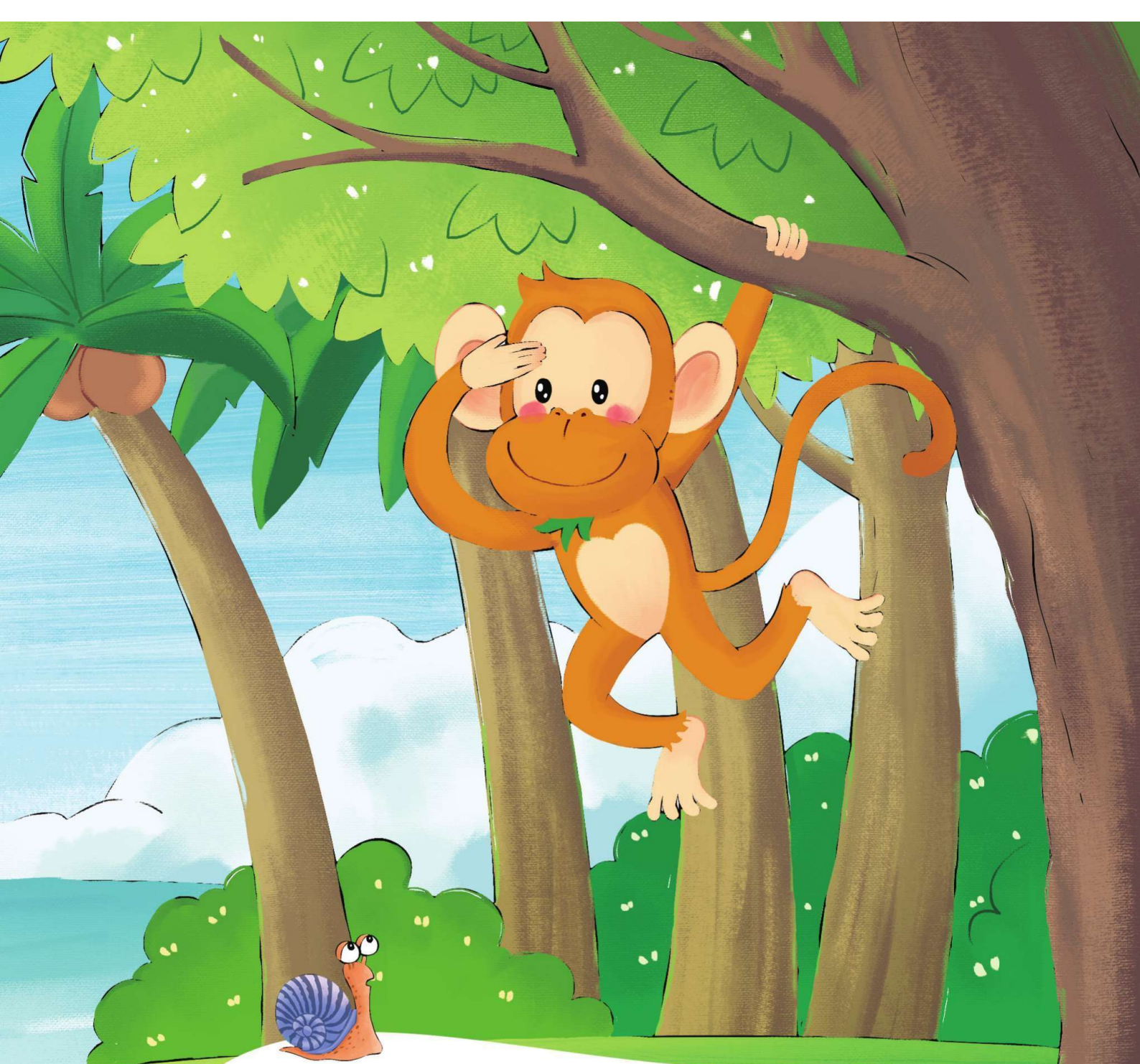


When autumn came,
