恒谦人就是登山者。八年的积淀，八年的追求，八年的攀登，最终获得了“恒谦教育”备考用书编写的全面成功！正是基于在高考备考复习方面的成功经验，并依托北京教育出版社恒谦教育研究院的强大教育资源，我们组织了全国数十所名校的百位名师编写了《超级备考高考系统复习》丛书。

《超级备考高考系统复习》作为高三师生的系统复习用书，与其他此类教辅在选题立意上有根本的区别：第一，编写理念创新。我们在认真研究目前高三师生复习现状和分析市场备考类用书优劣的基础上，理清了备考类用书的一种全新编写理念：系统复习+系统训练+信息追补，即《考试大纲》出台前侧重对教材知识的系统梳理和解题能力的综合训练，解决历年考纲中不变的考试内容；《考试大纲》出台后，侧重对高考信息的追补和考题预测，全真模拟最新款式要求的高考试卷，让考生零距离触摸高考考场。第二，备考思路转变。针对2007年高考的命题趋势，本丛书完全从师生备考的实际需要出发，依据教材或知识系统的先后顺序划分章节，纵向对教材进行复习，注重学科内综合的提炼与复习引导，突出对学科知识延展性和联系性的探究，体现了由“深挖洞”向“广积粮”备考思路的转变。第三，理清两大关系。本丛书严格依据《考试大纲》的最新精神和“新课标”的意图，结合地方自主命题的发展趋势，充分体现中央《考试大纲》对全国高考的统一要求和自主命题省区《考试说明》的地方特色（差异性）。

因为具有差异性，所以才具备存在性。《超级备考高考系统复习》特为备战2007年高考系统复习设计，专供高三师生系统复习时课堂同步使用（也可作为高三学生系统复习的自读类教辅）。丛书在编写上凸现了五大特点：

**一、版本完整，备考无忧。**考虑到2007年广东、山东、宁夏和海南将迎来新课标的首次高考，我们专门为它们编写了《超级备考高考系统复习》的新课标版；为使丛书能更好地指导自主命题省区2007年高考的备考复习，我们还特地编写了各省专用版，书稿由自主命题省区的备考名师主笔撰写或审定，以确保内容与各省高考自主命题的地方特色完全匹配。

**二、模式创新，功能齐备。**丛书采用教师用书+学生用书的“1+1”模式编写，体现了人性化设计的理念；并且“教师用书”配有备考光盘，容量大、信息全，为教师提供了信息查询和教学资源共享的平台。

#### I. 基础知识归纳解析(双单元中高考易考词汇、短语、句型及语法)

##### 1. loyal *adj.* 忠诚的, 忠心的

a loyal friend 忠实的朋友

He is a loyal soldier. 他是个忠诚的战士。

be loyal to... 忠于……, 忠诚于……, to 为介词, 后跟名词或代词。

be loyal to vow 信守誓约

We should be loyal to our country. 我们应该忠诚于我们的国家。

注意: loyalty *n.* [U] 忠诚

The loyalty of dogs to their owners is well-known.

狗对主人的忠心是众所周知的。

##### 2. argue

##### (1) *vi.* 争论, 辩论

argue  $\begin{cases} \text{about (on/over) 为……而争论} \\ \text{for 为赞成……争论} \\ \text{with 与……争论} \end{cases}$

##### (2) *vt.* 说理, 争辩

其后常接 the matter, the point, the question 之类的名词作宾语, 也可以接 that 引导的宾语从句。

We should argue for the justice.

We have been arguing on this problem for two hours.

The lawyers argued the case for hours.

The driver argued that he should not answer for the accident.

注意: argue 着重就自己的看法或立场提出论证, 和人家辩论。

quarrel 为不及物动词时, 意为“争吵、吵架”, 它表示一种由于不同意或不喜欢而产生激烈争论, 既可指言辞上的不和, 也可指唇枪舌剑的争吵。

They had even quarreled several times.

##### 3. too much, much too

I don't enjoy reading too much. 我不太喜欢读书。

too much 表示“过多”, “过分”, “太多”, “太”, 在句中可作状语, 多修饰不及物动词, 且位于不及物动词之后; too much 作定语时应修饰不可数名词; 它还可以单独作主语、宾语或表语, 代替不可数名词的概念或抽象概念。

be too much 意为“太过分; 受不了; (对……来说) 太困难; (对……来说) 做不来或太难了; 非(某人)力所能及的。”

much too 意为“太; 十分”, 它在句中作状语修饰形容词或副词。例如:

He is much too old. 他年纪太大了。(修饰形容词 old)

The horse is running much too fast. 马跑得太快了。(修饰副词 fast)

##### 4. beautiful, pretty, handsome, lovely

(1) beautiful 是最常用的, 意为“美丽的, 美好的”, 可指各种各样的美, 如花鸟、风景、图画的美, 也可指天气、曲调、衣服的美等。在形容人时, 一般用来指女子长得美丽、好看、动人。如:

① she has a beautiful voice.

② What a beautiful scene it is!

(2) pretty 也是普通用语, 意为“漂亮的, 标致的”。其漂亮程度不如 beautiful。用来修饰人时, 它指年轻的妇女和女孩, 侧重指身材和体形的苗条娇美, 显示活泼和甜美; 也可修饰表示“物”的名词, 内含“小巧玲珑”之意。

How pretty the girl looks in her new dress!

(3) handsome 多用于描写男人“英俊、标致”, 用于女性时主要指五官端正, 身体健康而不一定漂亮。

He was a handsome boy with large, bright eyes and fair hair.

(4) lovely “可爱的”, 常用于表达说话人对孩子、天气等的赞赏和喜爱。

What a lovely boy you have!

##### 5. hunt

##### (1) *vt.* 猎取(鸟、兽等), 狩猎

They hunted foxes.

##### (2) *vi.* 搜索, 寻找

hunt + (for/after) + 名词

hunt for something lost 寻找失物

hunt for a job 找工作

hunt + (in/through) + 名词 + (for + 名词) 搜(遍)(某处)以寻找……

I hunted the room for the glasses.

##### (3) *n.* 打猎, 狩猎

go on deer hunt 去猎鹿

##### 6. for example, for instance, such as

for example 与 for instance 同义, 用来举例证明前面的内容。句中用逗号隔开; such as “诸如”, 用于列举若干同类事物来说明前者所涉及的内容。

There are rare animals in Australia, for instance, koalas and duckbills.

澳洲有稀有动物, 例如考拉熊、鸭嘴兽。

He visited several cities such as New York, Chicago, and Boston.

7. share *v.* 共用; 共有; 分享; 均分; 分担; 参与某事。例如:

① The twins share the same tastes and interests. 这对双胞胎有共同的爱好和兴趣。

② We two share the bedroom. 我们两个共用一个卧室。

③ They would share the joys and sorrows. 他们会同甘共苦。

- share(in)sth. 分享/分担
- share sth. with sb. 与别人共有或合用某物
- share sth. (out)between/among sb. 在两者或多人间平均分配某物

例如:

① Let me share the umbrella with you. 让我和你共用这把雨伞吧。

② He shared the cake among the children. 他把蛋糕分给那些孩子们吃了。

8. especially, specially

(1) especially 尤其, 特别地, 含有超出其他之意, 常用于所强调的主语、介词短语、形容词及 when 引导的从句之前。

Cotton grows well, especially in their area.

棉花长势良好, 尤其是在他们那个地区。

(2) specially 特地地, 专门地, 强调有特色、不一般, 强调是专为某一特定目的而进行的特定行为。

The cake is specially made for your birthday.

这个蛋糕是专门为你的生日而做的。

9. admit

(1) *vt.* 允许进入, 允许参加

admit sb. /sth. into/to

She is admitted to a medical school. 她被录取到一所医学院校。

(2) 表示“可容纳”之意时, 可以跟数词, 引申为“有……的余地”, 后常跟 of 引起的介词短语。

This work admits of no delay. 这项工作不容拖延。

(3) *vt.* 作“承认”解时, 后面可以跟名词、动名词、名词性从句以及由“to be+*adj.*”作补足语的复合宾语。如:

Finally they had to admit defeat.

She admitted having done wrong.

He admitted to me that he had stolen the wallet.

They admitted my statement to be reasonable.

10. (1) so+be/助动词/情态动词+主语, 表示前面肯定的情况也适合于另外一个人或物。

① He's finished his homework, and so have I. (= He's finished his homework, and I have finished my homework, too.)

② If he goes there, so will she. (= If he goes there, she will go there, too.)

(2) so+主语+be/助动词/情态动词, 表示对前述情况的认同或强调, 注意前后是同一主语, 意为“的确, 确定”。

—It was cold yesterday.

—So it was. (= Yes, it was.)

(3) 主语+did+so, 表示主语照办了。

He asked me to wait for him and I did so.

(4) neither/nor+be/助动词/情态动词+主语。

表示前面否定的情况也适合另一种情况。

He failed in the exam, neither did I.

(5) 若前面陈述的是两种或两种以上的情况时, 则用

So it is with sb 或 It is/was the same with sb.

11. alone, lonely

alone *adj.* 作表语, 不能作定语, 意思是“独自一人”, 表示的是客观状态, 没有感情色彩。

alone *adv.* 表示“独自, 单独”, 当 alone 用于名词、代词后, 意思是“只有(only)”。

lonely *adj.* 可表示人“孤独的, 寂寞的”; 也可表示地方“荒凉的、人烟稀少的”, 既可作定语, 也可作表语。

I am alone, but I don't feel lonely.

We have no idea why he left the company. Tom alone knows the secret.

我们不知道为什么他要离开公司, 只有汤姆一个人知道这件事。

12. In order to survive, Chuck develops a friendship with an unusual friend—a volleyball he calls Wilson. 为了生存, 查克与一名异类朋友建立了友谊, 那是一只排球, 他管它叫威尔逊。

in order to 引出一个不定式短语, 在句中作目的状语, 此短语意为“为了……”。

in order to 短语作目的状语, 常可用 so as to 短语替换。不同的是, in order to 短语既可位于句尾又可位于句首, 而 so as to 短语则不能提到句首去。这两个短语之后要接动词原形, 它们的否定式分别为 in order not to do 和 so as not to do。

13. care about, care for, take care of

care about 与 care for 均有“关心、喜欢”之意, 但:

(1) care about 还可作“在乎、在意”解, 意思上相当于 mind, 常用于否定句。

She didn't care about anything people might say. 人们说什么她都不在乎。

(2) care for 还可以表示“照顾、照料”, 相当于 look after, attend.

The children are well cared for in the nurseries.

(3) take care of 意为“照顾”(look after)。

She takes good care of everybody.

14. majority, most

均可表示“大多数; 大部分”, 但用法不同。

majority 为名词, 常与 the 或 a 连用。作主语时, 指整体, 谓语动词用单数, 指许多个体时, 谓语则用复数。如:

The majority were/was for the plan. 多数人赞同这个计划。

The majority of his books are kept upstairs. 他的大部分

书藏在楼上。

most 表示“大部分”，通常作代词，前面一般不用冠词，后面常接“of+名词”结构。作主语时，谓语动词须与 of 后面的名词保持一致。

Most of the students want to study abroad.

Most of her money is spent on clothing.

15. stay up { 挺立、没倒塌  
熬夜

做某事有些/不/不怎么费力

注意：后面跟名词时可用 have difficulty with sth.

17. { except 除去，指在整体中除去行为未发生者。  
except for 整体中除去其中某个或某些因素。  
前后两个名词的性质不同。  
except that 后跟从句，除 that 外，还有 when,  
what, where 等。

except for“除了(有)……之外”，“要不是”，指在整体中除去其中某个或某些因素。except for 用来引述细节以修正句子的主要意思，except for 前后所述的两个名词性质不同或不属于同一概念。例如：

The movie was good except for the ending.

这部电影除了结尾之外都很好。(the movie 是整体，the ending 是 the movie 之中的一部分，movie 和 ending 不属于同一概念。)

except“除去，除掉”，表示完全除开，except 前后所述的两个词性质相同或属于同一概念。except 表示此意时可用 but 替换，不过 but 通常只用在 all, everything, everyone, nothing, who, what, no, nobody, nothing, anywhere, none 等之后，此种情况与 except 通用，否则用 except。例如：

Everybody except/but Jack was able to answer. 除了杰克之外大家都能回答。(言下之意杰克不能回答，完全除开杰克。everybody 和 Jack 都指人，属同一概念。)

except that，“除去，除掉”，其后接从句。除 that 之外，还有 except when, except where, except what, 它们之后都接句子。例如：

① I know nothing about him except that he is from America.

我除了知道他是美国人之外，对他的其他情况一无所知。

② He goes to the library every day except when he is not well.

他除了身体不舒服的时候以外，每天都上图书馆。

③ My papers seem to be everywhere except where they ought to be.

我的文件似乎完全不在它们应该放置的地方。

### 一、完形填空

"You can learn English more efficiently(效率高的) if you spend 20 minutes a day for a week than if you spend two hours a day." This is what a teacher usually says when he tells his students 1 allot(分配) their time. But is it true?

Suppose you have a bucket 2 a small hole in its bottom. Now you are asked 3 the bucket with the water in a basin. If you are too little a boy to lift the basin 4 water, you are sure 5 use of a bowl or something alike. You will dip out the water from the basin with the bowl and 6 it into the bucket. You may dip from the basin again and again. However, you will soon 7 that as soon as you pour a bowl of water into the bucket, most of the water leaks out through the 8, so you are 9 able to fill up the bucket this way.

On the contrary, if you are an adult, you will undoubtedly 10 the basin and pour the whole basin of water into the bucket at once. Now, the bucket is full. Though the water in it is also leaking out, you at least have filled up the bucket with water. If you want 11 the bucket full, you only 12 add a bowl of water now and then.

The same is true of English learning. Let us 13 a simple example. If you learn 10 new words today, you are most likely to remember nine 14. But if you try to learn 30 words today, though you may forget 15 more than one word, you may still be able to remember 11 or 12 words tomorrow.

Day in and day 16, you will be able to remember a large number of words, 17 you may forget some of them.

In short, the more time you spend at a time, the more you will learn on the whole. Of course, 18 time you spend each time must be 19 the limit that you do not exhaust(使筋疲力尽) 20.

## 二、阅读理解

### How Long Can People Live?

She took up skating at age 85, made her first movie appearance at age 114, and held a concert in the neighborhood on her 121st birthday.

When it comes to long life, Jeanne Calment is the world's recordholder. She lived to the ripe old age of 122. So is 122 the upper limit to the human life span (寿命)? If scientists come up with some sort of pill or diet that would slow aging, could we possibly make it to 150 or beyond?

Researchers don't entirely agree on the answers. "Calment lived to 122, so it wouldn't surprise me if someone alive today reaches 130 or 135," says Jerry Shay, at the University of Texas.

Steve Austad at the University of Texas agrees. "People can live much longer than we think," he says, "experts used to say that humans couldn't live past 110. When Calment blew past that age, they raised the number to 120. So why can't we go higher?"

The trouble with guessing how old people can live to be is that it's all just guessing. "Anyone can make up a number," says Rich Miller at the University of Michigan. "Usually the scientist who picks the highest number gets his name in Time magazine."

"Won't new anti-aging techniques keep us alive for centuries? Any cure," says Miller, "for aging would probably keep most of us kicking until about 120." Researchers are working on treatments that lengthen the life span of mice by 50 percent at most. "So, if the average human life span is about 80 years," says Miller, "adding another 50 percent would get you to 120."

So what can we conclude from this little disagreement among the researchers? "That life span is flexible (有弹性的), but there is a limit," says George Martin of the University of Washington. "We can get flies to live 50 percent longer," he says, "but a fly's never going to live 150 years." "Of course, if you became a new species (物种), one that ages at a slower speed, that would be a different story," he adds.

Does Martin really believe that humans could evolve (进化) their way to longer life? "It's pretty cool to think about it," he says with a smile.

### 1. consider

consider *vt.* 作“考虑”讲时,后可加名词、动名词、疑问词加不定式或从句作宾语;作“认为,把……看作……”时,后跟宾语加补足语的复合结构或宾语从句。如:

① I asked him to consider my suggestion carefully before he made his decision.

在他作决定之前,我要他仔细考虑我的建议。

② I'm considering changing my job.

我正在考虑改变职业。

③ He is such an honest man that we all consider him(as) our friend.

他是一个诚实的人,以至于我们都把他看作我们的朋友。

④ You can't consider him(to be) a selfish man.

你不能把他当作一个自私的人。

⑤ We're considering what to do next.

2. means

means *n.* 意思是“方式,方法,手段”,单复数同形。“用这种方法”有多种表达法,注意不同介词的搭配:by this means; in this way; with this method。例如:

① There are(is) no means of getting there.

没有办法到达那里。

② You can finish the job by means of asking him for some advice.

你可以用向他征求意见的方法完成这件工作。

③ We express our feelings by means of words.

我们借助语言表达感情。

3. in future 与 in the future 的区别

in future = from now on, 表示“今后”,强调与过去相对照,过去是什么,今后将是什么情况,常指全部的将来。in the future 表示“将来”,指较长时间的将来。in the near future 指“在不久的将来”。如:

① He has made up his mind to work harder than before in future.

他下决心从今以后比以前更加努力地学习。

② Who can tell what will happen in the future?

谁能知道将来会发生什么?

③ I'm sure that he will come to understand this in the near future.

我敢肯定在不久的将来他会慢慢明白这一点的。

4. experience

experience 用作可数名词时,意思是“经历,阅历”;用作不可数名词时,意思是“经验”。be/become experienced in/at (doing) something. 意思是“对……有经验”。experienced 是形容词作表语,它还可用作定语,意思是“熟练的,有经验的”。此外 experience 还可用作动词,意思是“经历,体会”。如:

① He is experienced in driving the truck.

他有驾驶卡车的经验。

② Her mother is an experienced teacher. That is, she has much experience in teaching.

她妈妈是一个有经验的老师,也就是说,她有着丰富的教学经验。

③ She had many experiences while traveling in France.

5. try doing 与 try to do 的区别

try doing something 尝试做某事; try to do something 努力去某事。有些动词后既可跟不定式,也可跟动名词,但意思差别很大。一般用不定式表示尚未发生的动作;用动名词表示发生过的动作,须牢记它们的区别。这类动词有:

① remember to do something 记着去做某事

remember doing something 记得做了某事

② forget to do something 忘了做某事

forget doing something 忘了做过某事

③ regret to say/tell 遗憾地讲,抱歉地说

regret doing/having done something 后悔做了某事

④ mean to do something 打算做某事

mean doing something 意味着做某事

⑤ stop to do something 停下来做另一件事

stop doing something 停止做某事

⑥ go on doing exercise 不停地锻炼

go on to do exercise 接下来继续锻炼

⑦ leave off writing the book 不写书了

leave off to write the book 为写书而离开某地。

6. in time

in time 意思是“及时,迟早”;on time 准时,按时。

① We caught the train in time yesterday.

昨天,我们及时地赶上了火车。

② He is sure to succeed in time.

他迟早会成功的。

③ The meeting is to begin at seven. Everyone should be present on time. 会议七点钟开始,每个人应该准时出席。

7. get away from

get away from 意思是“从……逃脱,离开”。与 get 搭配的常见的短语还有: get along/on with 和……相处,进展; get done with 结束,完成; get down to something/doing something 开始(认真)干某事; get in touch with 和某人取得联系,等等。如:

① The thief got away from the policeman when they got off the bus. 当他们下车时,小偷突然从警察手里逃脱。

② He is getting along/on well with his classmates. 他和他的同学相处得很好。

③ They got done with the bridge last month.

他们上个月就建成了这座桥。

④ Now stop talking. Let's get down to preparing for the meeting.

现在,不要讲话了。让我们为会议作准备吧。

⑤ They got in touch with each other by e-mail.

他们通过电子邮件取得了联系。

8. 句型: It is/was + adj. / n. + 真正的主语

常用于此句型的形容词有: clear, true, strange, impossible, easy 等; 常用于此句型的名词有: a pity, a wonder, a mistake, a waste, no use, no good 等。真正的主语有三种:

(1) 用 for 或 of 引起的短语作不定式的逻辑主语, 如 for somebody to do something; of somebody to do something.

(2) 在一些特定的词或词组后, 如: no use, no good, worth while 等后, 习惯上用 v. -ing.

(3) 由 that 或连接代词或副词引起的从句。例如:

① It's clear that he is going to win the game.

② It's no use waiting for him. He's coming.

③ It's important for a student to master a foreign language.

② We'll have tea in the garden instead of in the house.

我们要在院子里而不是在屋子里喝茶。

③ Miss Green is ill. I'll give you the lesson instead.

(2) way 还可用作先行词,之后为定语从句。the way 在定语从句中作方式状语,故其后可用 in which, 或者使用 that, 或省略不用。例如:

① I don't like the way you speak to her.
