Massive(大)flooding in India , Nepal , Bhutan , and Bangladesh has left hundreds dead and about one 原million homeless援Rivers rushing down the Himalayas have destroyed bridges and communications , killed farm animals , and made hundreds of thousands of hectares (公顷)of farm land unusable援Relief officials are hard pressed to meet demands for food , fresh water , clothing , and shelter(避难所)援And they fear and outbreak of disease caused by poor environment(环境)and dirtied water 援

Experts believe that massive de 原forestation in the Himalayas is a important cause in such flooding援Trees prevent the loss of soil 援Destroying forests means too much rain runs off barren hills carrying tons of soil 援This raises the level of river beds , which causes water to pill over dams and banks 援The result is flooding 援

All her life , Mrs 援Foster had had such a strong fear of missing a train , a plane , a boat or even the start of a play that her fear was almost an illness 援In other respects , she was not a particularly nervous woman , but just the thought of being late on occasions like these used to throw her into a terrible state 援As a result , a small muscle in the corner of her left eye would begin to tremble 援It was not very much , but the annoying(令人烦恼的)thing was that the problem refused to disappear until an hour or so after the train or plane—or whatever it was—had been safely caught 援

It is really strange how in certain people a simple fear about a thing like catching a train can grow into serious anxiety 援At least half an hour before it was time to leave the house for the station , Mrs Foster used to step out of the lift all ready to go , and then , as she was unable to sit down , she used to move about from room to room until her husband , who must have known about her state of mind , finally joined her and suggested in a cool dry voice that perhaps they had better go now , had they not ?

Mr 援Foster any possibly had a right not to be annoyed by this silliness of his wife 's but he could have had no excuse for increasing her anxiety by keeping her waiting unnecessarily 援It is not , of course , certain that this is what he did , but whenever they were going somewhere , his timing was do exact—just a minute or two late , you understand—and his manner so calm that it was hard to believe that he was not purposely causing pain to the unhappy lady 援He must have known that she would never dare to call out and tell him to hurry 援He had rained her too well for that 援He must also have known that if he was prepared to wait just a little longer than his wife , he could make her nearly crazy 援On one or two special occasions in the later years of their married life , it seemed almost as though he had wanted to moss the train , simply to increase the poor woman 's suffering 援

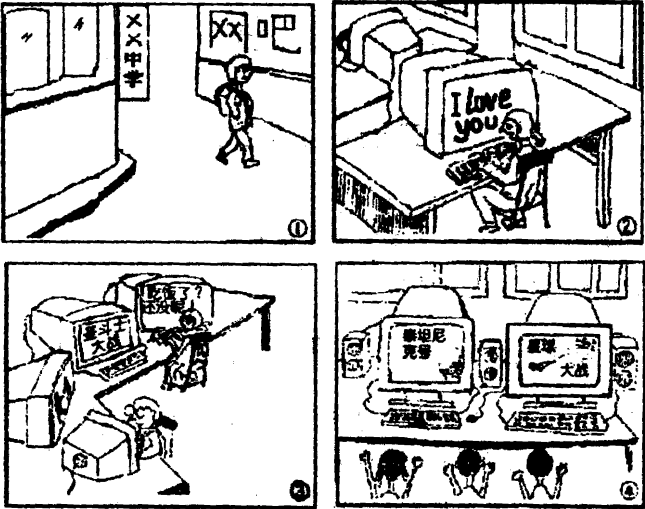

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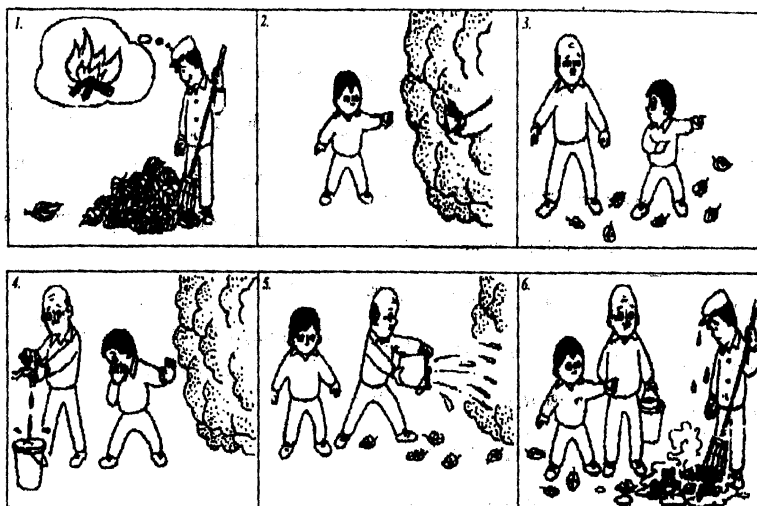
