## 《词类变化百分百》前言

鉴于此,我们编写了这本口语书——《词类变化百分百》。本书是每日5分钟系列丛书之一,主要是针对如何尽快提高口语而设计的,内容是关于100个常用词汇及其转化词的对话和练习。它拥有以下三大特点:

### 1 情景交融,身临其境。

本书围绕100个主词编写了100个短小精炼的对话。每个对话的前面都用两、三个句子来介绍有关该对话的背景及将要出场的人物。对话的内容贴近生活,人物的情感线索分明,发生的故事与所描绘的场景相符。可谓情景交融,极富真情实感,读来犹如身临其境。

### 2 英汉对译,一目了然。

本书中每一个人物对话都是先英文后中文,以利于读者与自己理解的意思相对照,防止理解上出现误差。句子活泼生动,朗朗上口,简单易懂,便于记忆,可以即学即用。

### 3 说学结合,一举两得。

本书的最大一个特点是以动词为主词,附

加由主词派生出来的名词、形容词、副词等编写出的一段段对话。我们在练习日常口语的同时,也可以学习这些常用词汇及其用法,可谓一举两得。

《词类变化百分百》将帮助你尽快提高口语能力,实现与老外顺利沟通,流利的英语脱口而出将不再是遥不可及的梦想!
