Brenda: Yeah. I caught a bad cold.

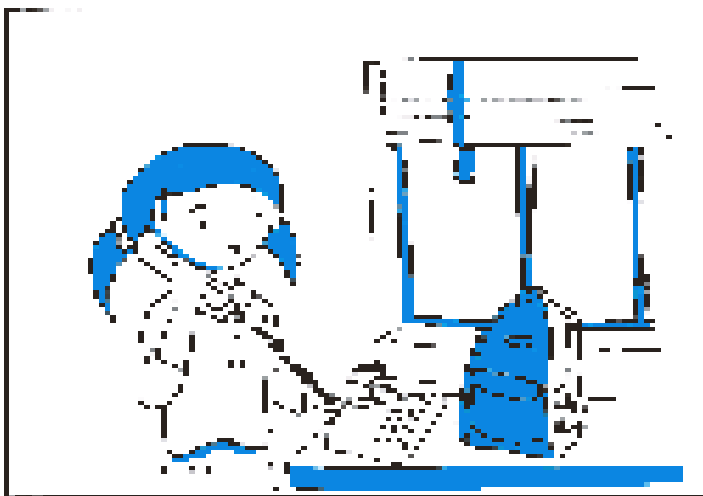
Susan: I am sorry to hear that, dear. You should go to see the
