我的帽子不见了。我不知把它放哪了。

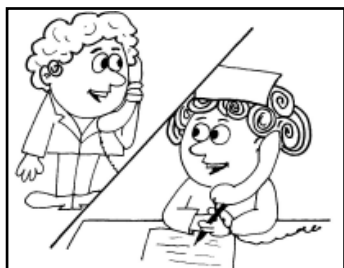

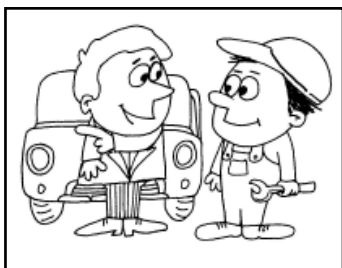

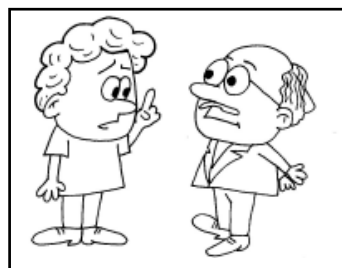
