1. 询问意见

你对……怎么看？

What do you think about . . . ?

What do you think about the election results?

你对选举结果怎么看？

I thought it turned out quite well.

我认为结果相当不错。

More

What is your opinion about (of) the election results?

你对选举结果有何意见？

What your views on (reaction to; feelings about) the election results?

你对选举结果持何种观点（有何反应；有何感想）？

What your feelings on the election results?

你对选举结果有何感想？

What do you have to say about the election results?

你对选举结果有什么说法？

What did you think of the election results?

你怎么看待选举结果？

What about the election results?

选举结果如何？

Clue-in

- ☛ “What do you think about ... ?” 用来表示询问他人的观点。
- ☛ “How do you think about ... ?” 和 “How do you feel about ... ?” 意为 “你对 怎么看？” “what” 意为 “什么”，“how” 意为 “怎么”。“How do you think about ... ?” 和 “How do you feel about ... ?” 可以表达同样的意思。
- ☛ views (on) : 观点 ; reaction (to) : 反应 ; feelings (about) : 感想。

你对.....有何反应？

How would you react to -ing ... ?

How would you react to replacing our sales manager?

你对更换我们的销售经理有何看法？

I'm afraid that's what we might have to do.

恐怕我们不得不这么做。

What would you say to replacing our sales manager?

你对更换我们的销售经理怎么看？

What would you think if we replaced our sales manager?

如果我们更换了销售经理，你会怎么想？

 **Clue-in**

☞ 准备询问他人的意见可以用这种表达方法。

告诉我你对.....的观点。

Give me your opinion on . . .

Give me your opinion on taxes.

告诉我你对税收的观点。

I think that taxes are far too high.

我认为税金太高了。

 **More**

Let me have your opinion on taxes.

告诉我你在税收方面的观点。

Tell me what you think about taxes.

告诉我你对税收的看法。

 **Clue-in**

☞ 比较直接地询问他人的意见可以用这种表达方法。

你的意见呢？

What about you ?

I don't think much of the President's speech. What about you?

我认为总统的演讲并不高明。你的意见呢？

I was a little disappointed too.

我也有一点失望。

More

How about you?

你怎么看？

What did you think?

你是怎么想的？

你不认为……？

Don't you think ...?

Don't you think we should hurry?

你不认为我们应该抓紧些吗？

No we have plenty of time.

不，我们的时间足够了。

More

You don't think we should hurry!

你不觉得我们得快些吗！

We should't hurry!

我们得快点吧！

Clue-in

- ☪ “Don't you think ... ?” 是比较尊重他人的一种反问方式

☞ “You don't think ... !” 则表示了一种对立的态度。

你对它的印象如何？

How did it grab you ?

I just read Henry's speech draft.

我刚刚读过亨利的演讲稿。

How did it grab you? I know he spent a lot of time on it.

对它的印象如何？我觉得他在那上面花了大量时间。

 **More**

How was it?

怎么样？

How did it hit you?

你对它有何印象？

 **Clue-in**

☞ “grab” 意为“吸引注意力”；“hit” 意为“打动”。

☞ 这是指关系比较近的人之间的一种询问方式。

你对……有何反应？

How did you react to ... ?

How did you react to the news?

你对那条消息怎么看？

I couldn't believe it.

我不能相信。

 **More**

What was your reaction to the news?

你对那条消息作何反应？

How did you respond to the news?

你对那条消息有什么看法？

你觉得……怎么样？


How are you finding . . . ?

How are you finding married life?

你觉得婚后生活怎么样？

I love it.

我很喜欢。

 **More**

How do you find married life?

婚后生活如何？

How does married life suit you?

你觉得婚后生活怎么样呀？

 **Clue-in**

☞ 询问他人就职、婚姻的情况时，用这种表达方法。

你对……有何看法？


How did you feel about . . . ?

How did you feel about the meeting?

你觉得会议如何？

I thought it was a waste of time.

我认为那是在浪费时间。

 **More**

How do you see the meeting?

你怎么看待那个会议？

你对……的感想是什么？


What are your feelings about . . . ?

What are your feelings about politics?

你对政治有何感想？

I guess I'm rather conservative.

我想我是颇为保守的。

 **More**

Do you have any (strong) opinions about politics?

你对政治有什么看法？

能告诉我你对..... 的看法吗？

May I ask what you think about ... ?

May I ask what you think about New York?

能告诉我你对纽约的看法吗？

I quite enjoy it.

我很喜欢那儿

 **More**

So what do you think about New York ?

那么你对纽约有何印象？

Are you enjoying your stay in New York ?

你现在在纽约过得愉快吗？

Are you having a good time in New York ?

你现在在纽约过得好吗？

 **Clue-in**

☞ 表达比较正式的询问方式。而 More 中则表明关系较近的人之间的询问。

要是.....那我们该怎么办呢？

What should we do if ... ?

What should we do if the hospital is already closed ?

要是医院已经关门了那我们该怎么办呢？

We'll just have to wait until morning.

我们只好等到早上了。

More

What if the hospital is ready closed ?

要是医院已经关门了呢？

What will we do if the hospital is already closed ?

要是医院已经关门了，我们怎么办？

你能想象 ?

Can you imagine -ing ...?

Can you imagine winning the lottery ?

你能想象中了彩票吗？

That would be great ?

那就太棒了！

Can you imagine what it would be like to win the lottery ?

你能想象中了彩票会怎样吗？

What are you going to do if you win the lottery ?

如果中了彩票你打算怎么做？

2. 表达你的意见

我认为……

I think . . .

I think (that) we should cancel the show.

我认为我们应该取消展览。

But it's too late to cancel.

但是太晚了不能取消了。

 **More**

I feel (that) we should cancel the show.

我觉得应该取消展览。

I believe (that) we should cancel the show.

我认为应该取消展览。

 **Clue-in**

- ☾ “think”, 的用法比较普遍, “believe” 的语气比较强, 表示非常确信, 而 “feel” 语气相对而言较弱。

我认为……

In my view, . .

In my view, we shouldn't wait any longer.

我认为我们不应该再等了。

But we need more time to plan.

但是我们需要更多时间来做计划。

 **More**

In my opinion, we shouldn't wait any longer.

我认为我们不应该再等了。

From my point of view, we shouldn't wait any longer.

在我看来我们不应该再等了。

 **Clue-in**

☪ 表示从第一人称的角度来表达观点。

如果你问我.....

If you ask me, . . .

If you ask me, the bus has already left.

如果你问我，公共汽车已经走了。

I think it's still on its way.

我认为它还在半路上。

 **More**

If you want my opinion, the bus has already left.

如果你听我的意见，公共汽车已经走了。

You may not want my opinion, but I think the bus has already left.

你也许不想听我的，但我认为公共汽车已经走了。

我想说.....

I'd say . . .

I'd say we support Sally's proposal.

我想说我们支持萨利的建议。

That's what I think.

我同意。

More

I'd say we support Sally's proposal.

我们支持萨利的建议。

I recommend that we support Sally's proposal.

我提议支持萨利的建议。

Clue-in

- ☾ “I would (should) say” 的缩写形式为 “I'd say” 表示个人的意见。

据我所知 ,.....

As far as I'm concerned, . . .

As far as I'm concerned, George is the best candidate.

据我所知 , 乔治是最佳的候选人。

George? You're kidding.

乔治? 开玩笑!

More

The way I see it, George is the best candidate.

依我看，乔治是最佳候选人。

From where I stand, George is the best candidate.

就我的立场看，乔治是最佳候选人。

Clue-in

- ☉ “As far as I’m concerned, . . .” 为固定用法，意为“据我所知”。

看来.....

It looks like . . .

It looks like the stock market is going to drop again.

看来股市要再度下跌了。

No, it can't get any lower than it already is.

不，不可能再低了。

More

It (sure) looks as if the stock market is going to drop again.

看起来股市会再度下跌。

Clue-in

- ☉ 此处用来表达判断。

我们很可能.....


We'll probably . . .

We'll probably have to find a new investor.

我们很可能要去找一位新的投资人了。

I guess you're right.

我想你是对的。

 **More**

We're probably going to have to find a new investor.

我们很可能要去找一位新的投资人了。

We're likely going to have to find a new investor.

我们可能要去找一位新的投资人了。

 **Clue-in**

- ☾ “probably” 意为大概，或许；而“likely” 意为或许，很可能，“likely” 的程度更深。

我确信.....

I'm convinced that . . .

I'm convinced that we need to sell our house and move.

我确信我们需要卖掉房子然后搬家。

Maybe you're right.

也许你是对的。
